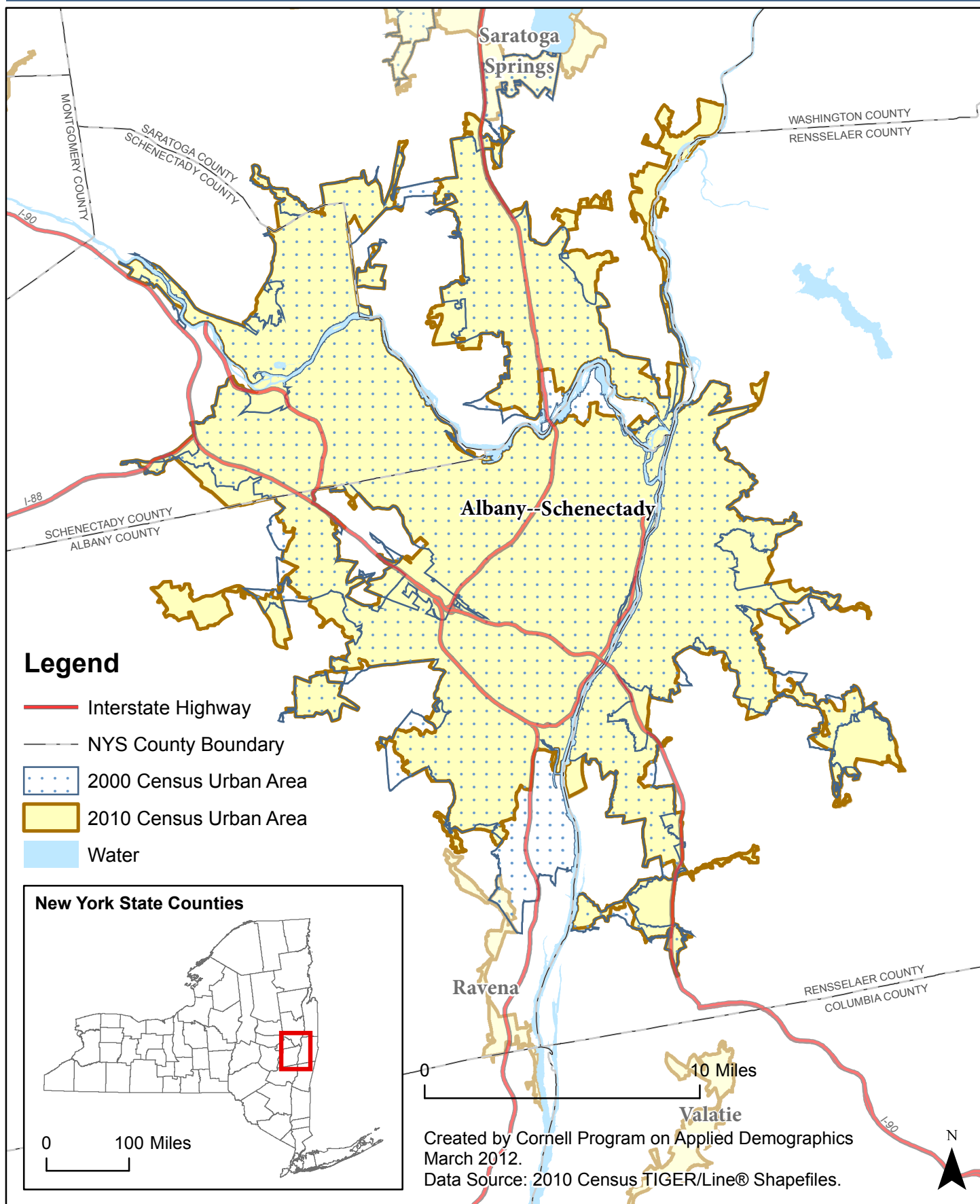

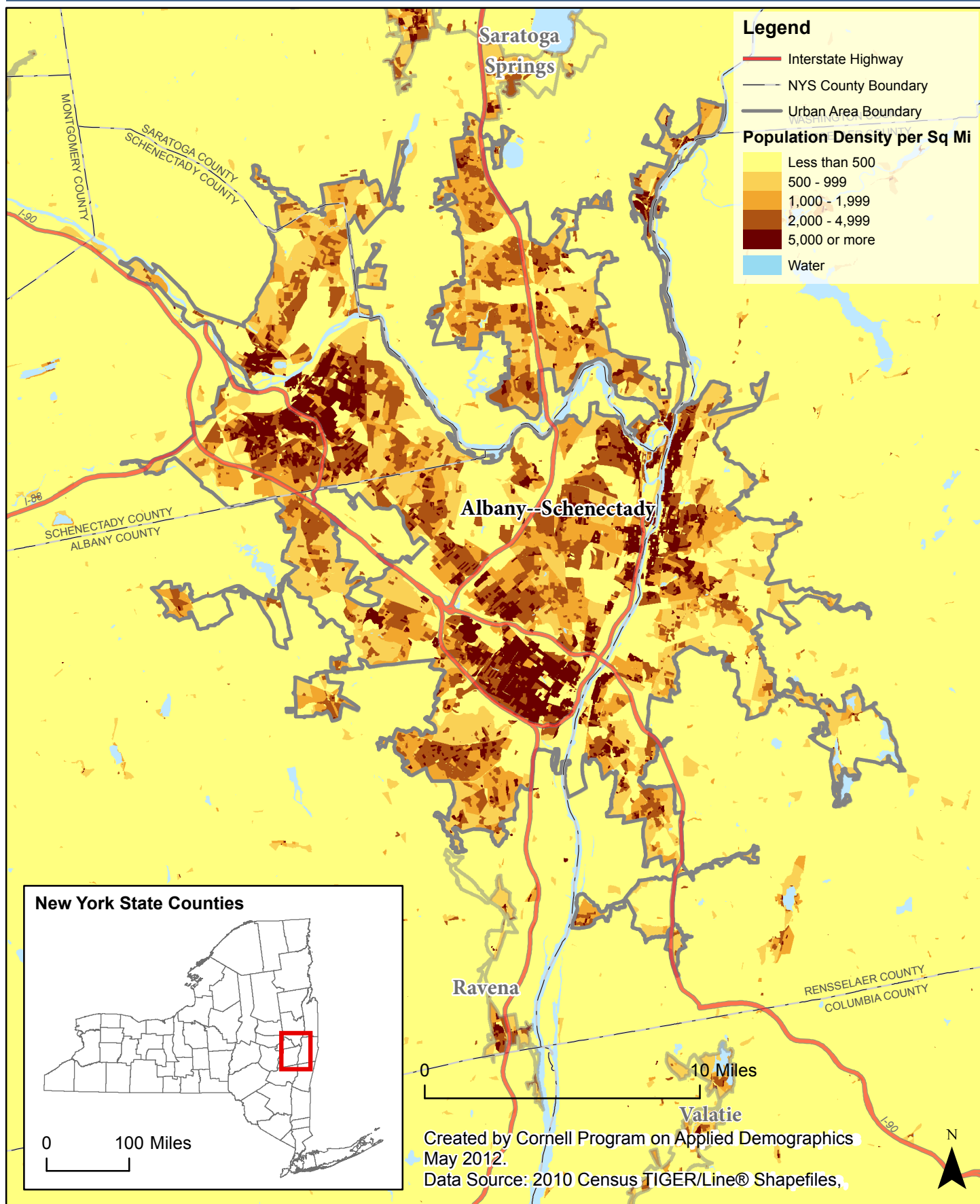
2010 Census Urban Area: Albany--Schenectady, NY

In Comparison With 2000 Census Urban Area



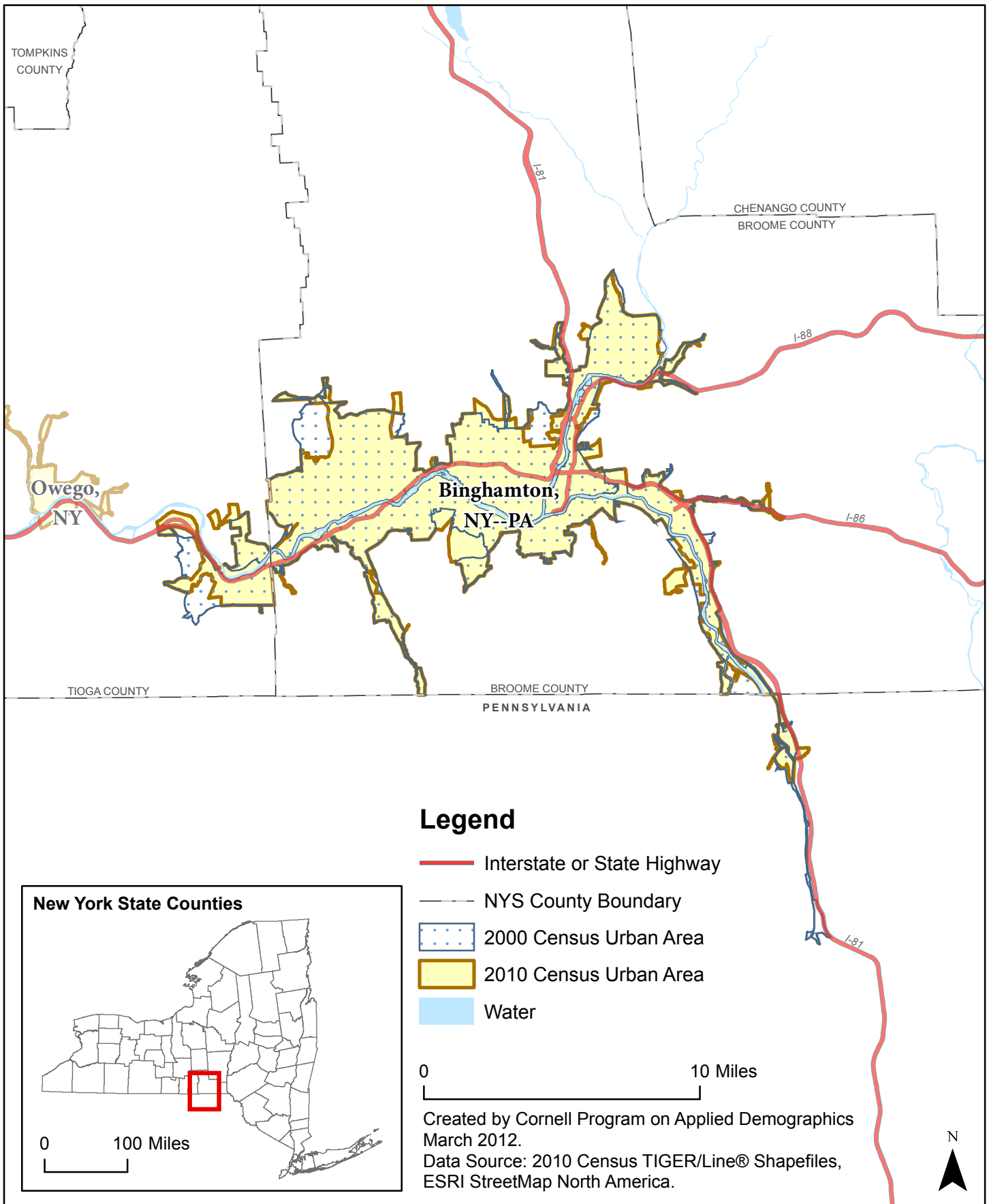

2010 Population Density Per Census Block



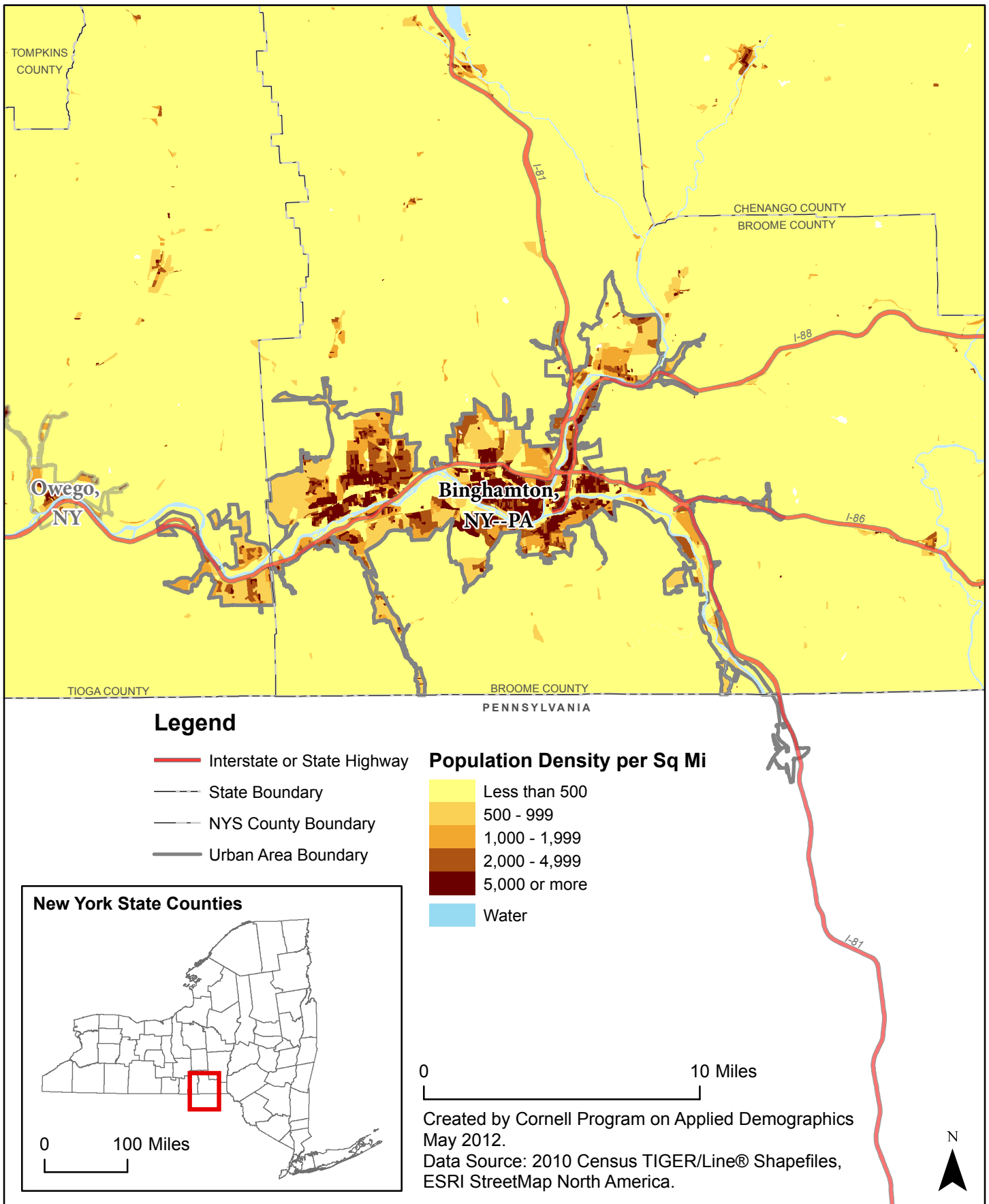
2010 Census Urban Area: Binghamton, NY--PA

In Comparison With 2000 Census Urban Area



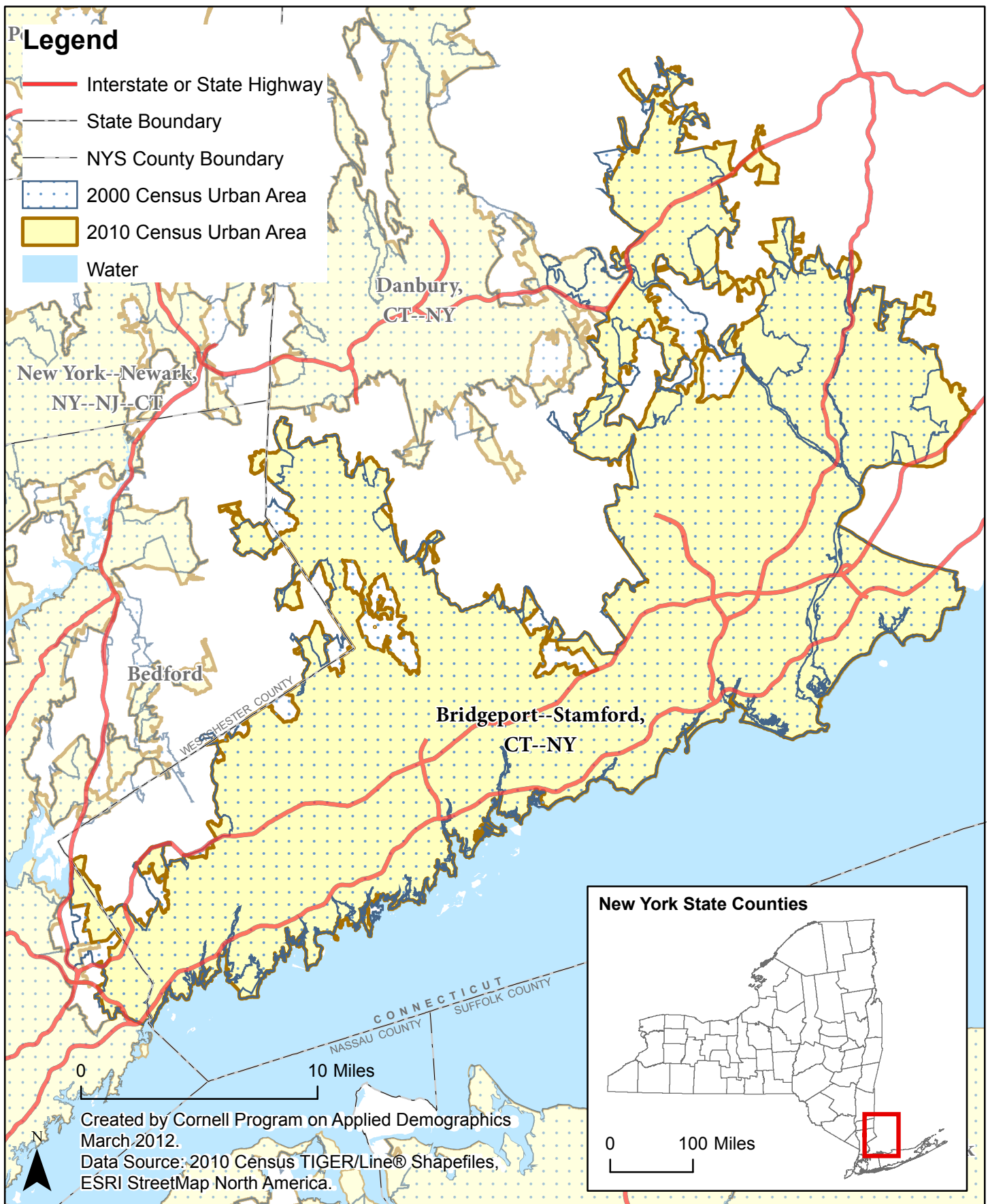

2010 Population Density Per Census block



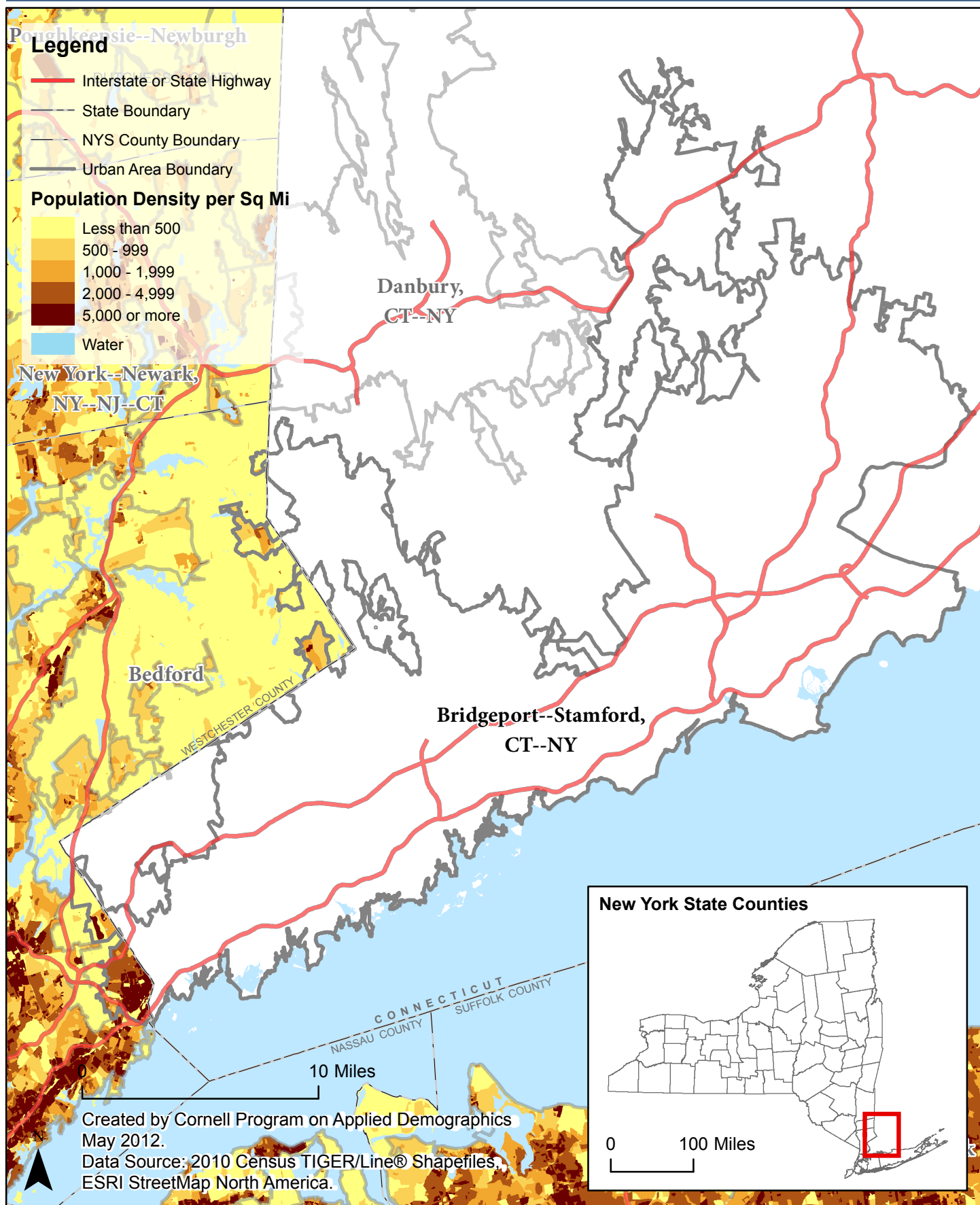
2010 Census Urban Area: Bridgeport--Stamford, CT--NY

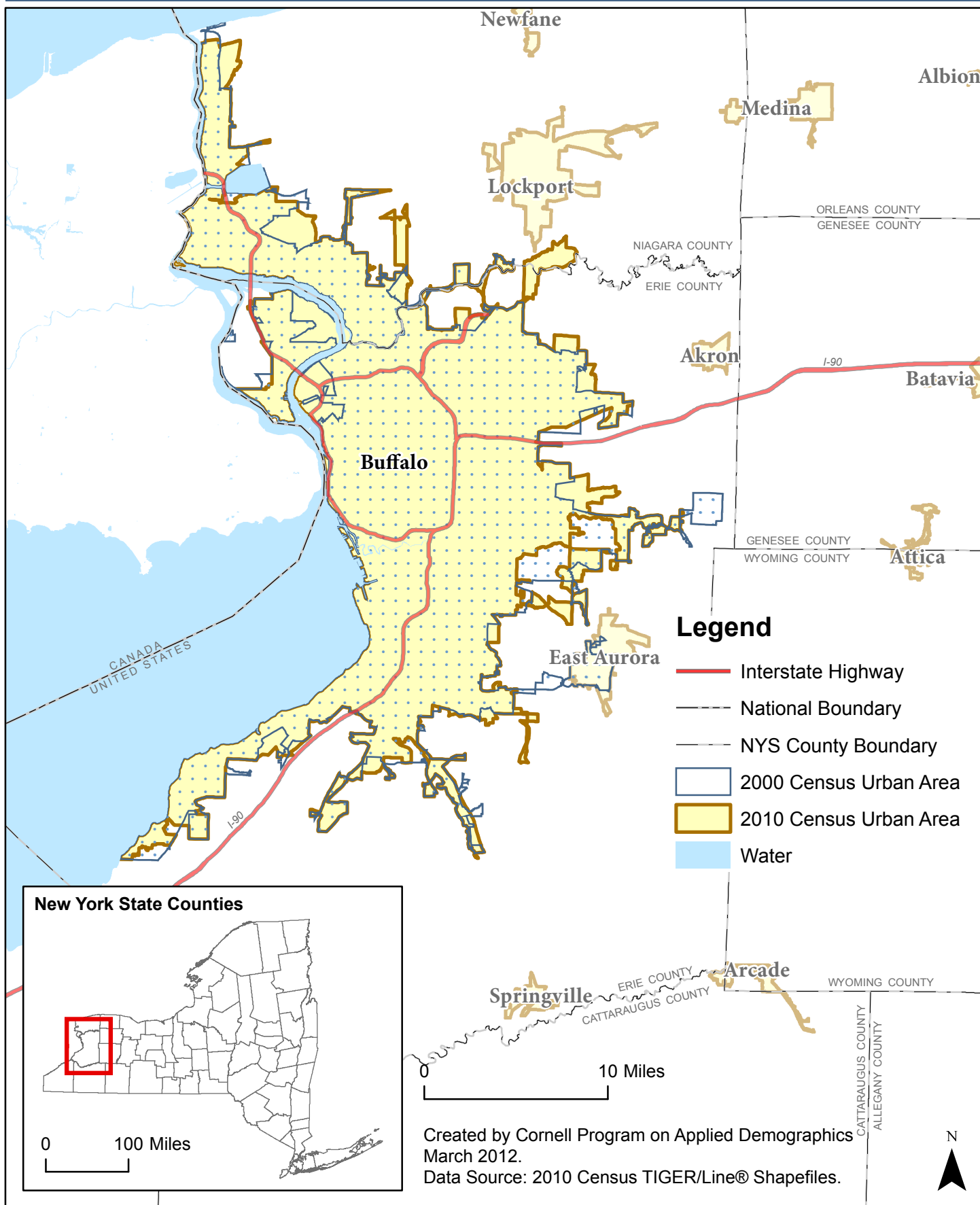

2010 Population Density Per Census Block



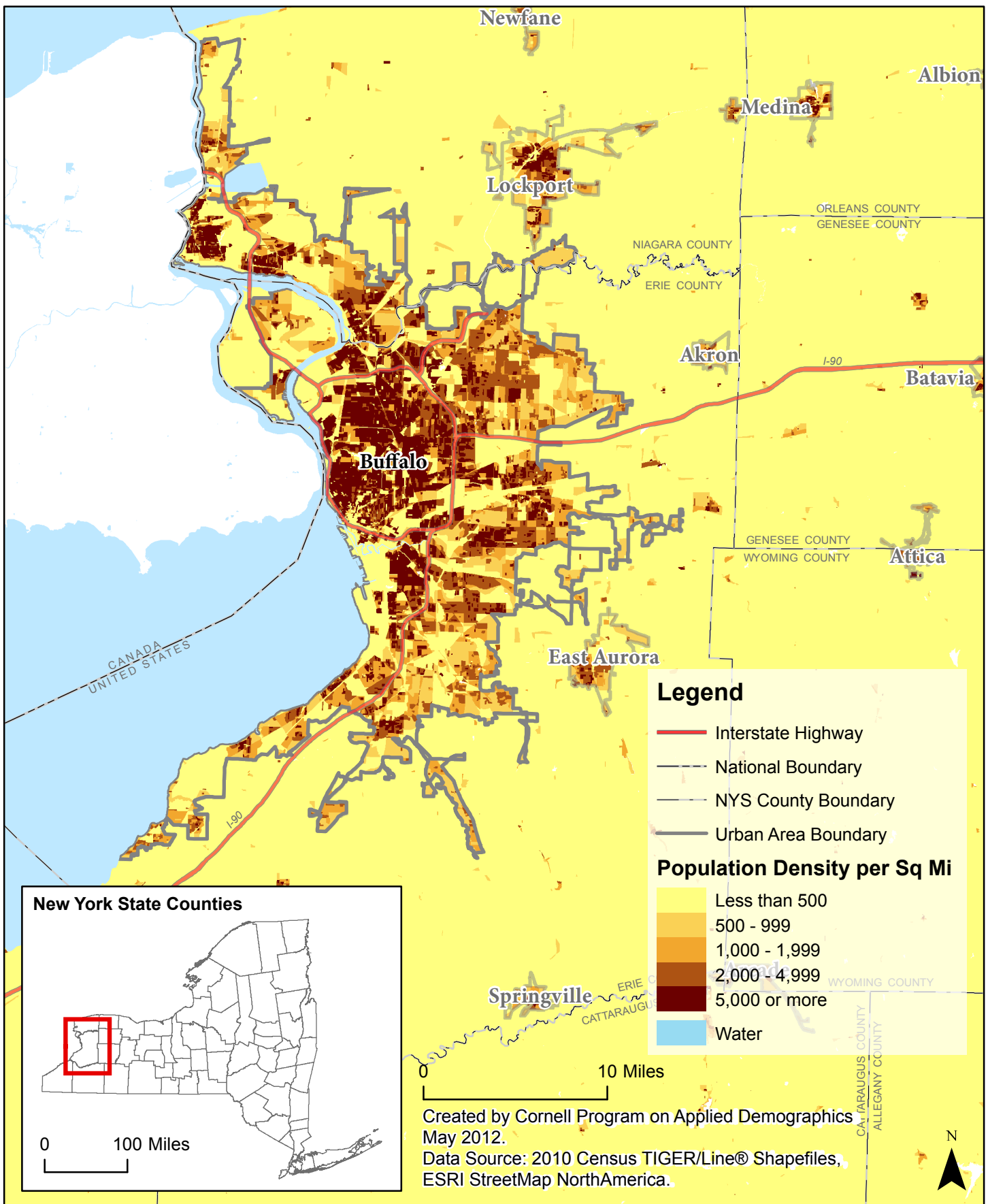

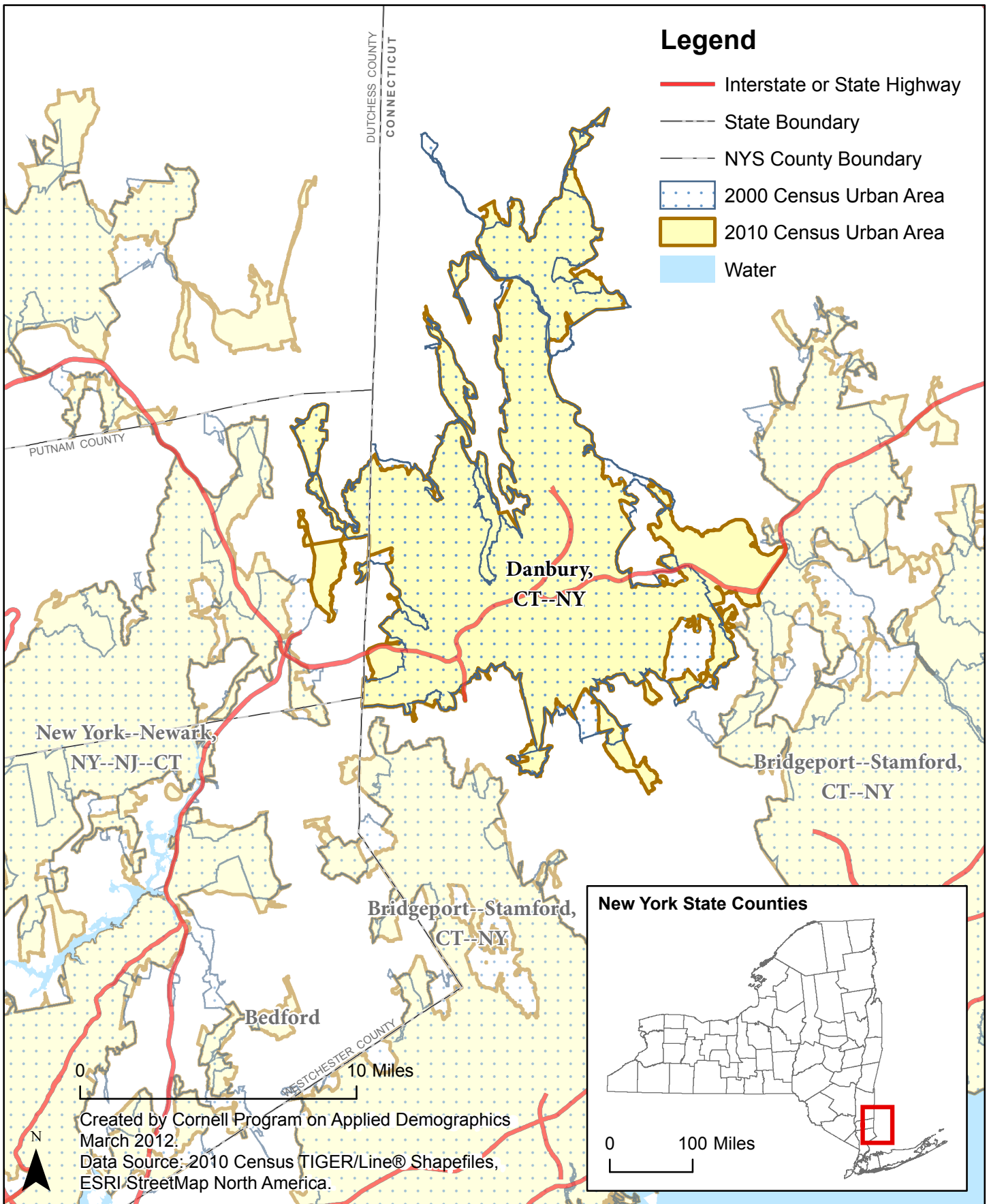

2010 Population Density Per Census block



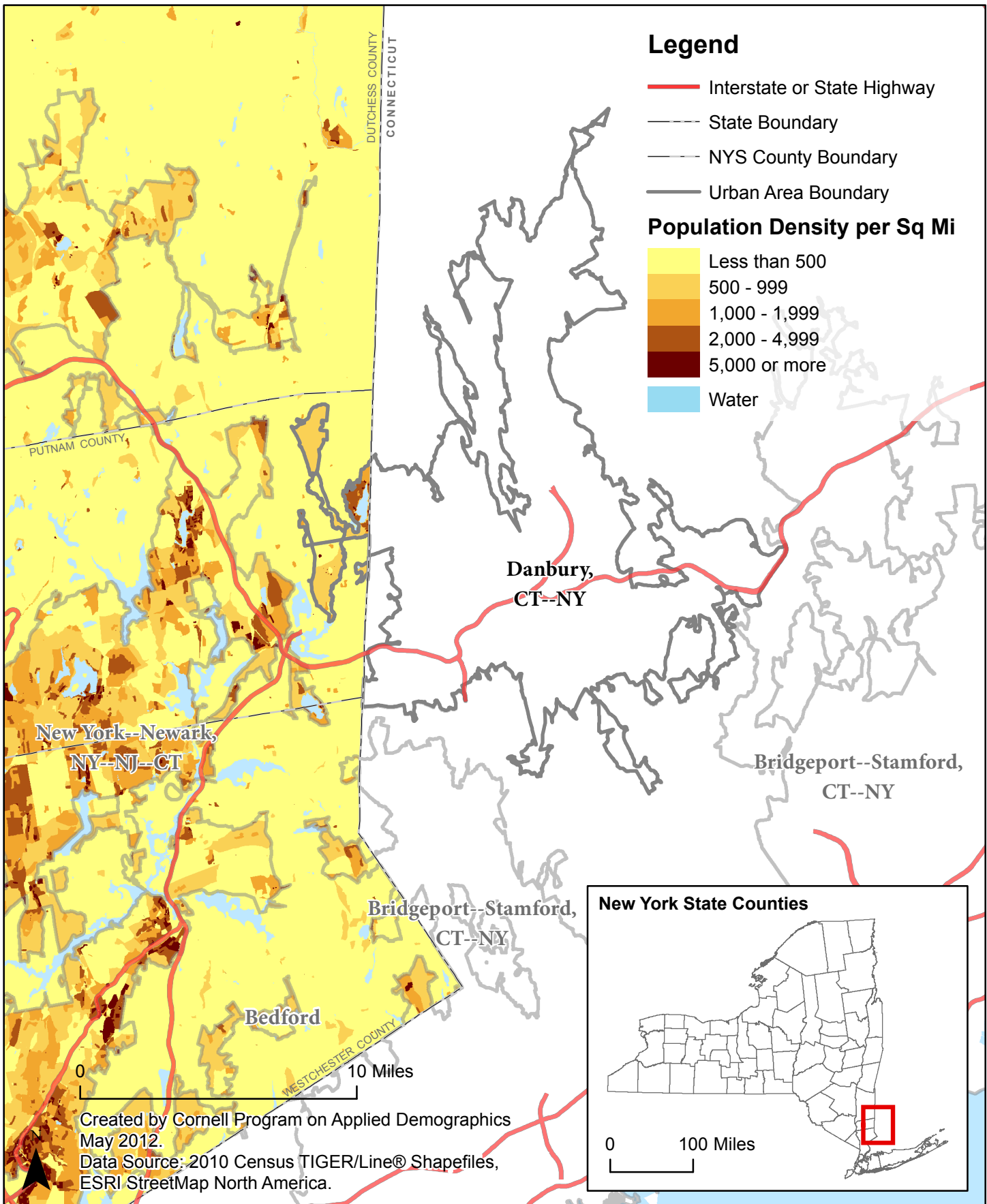

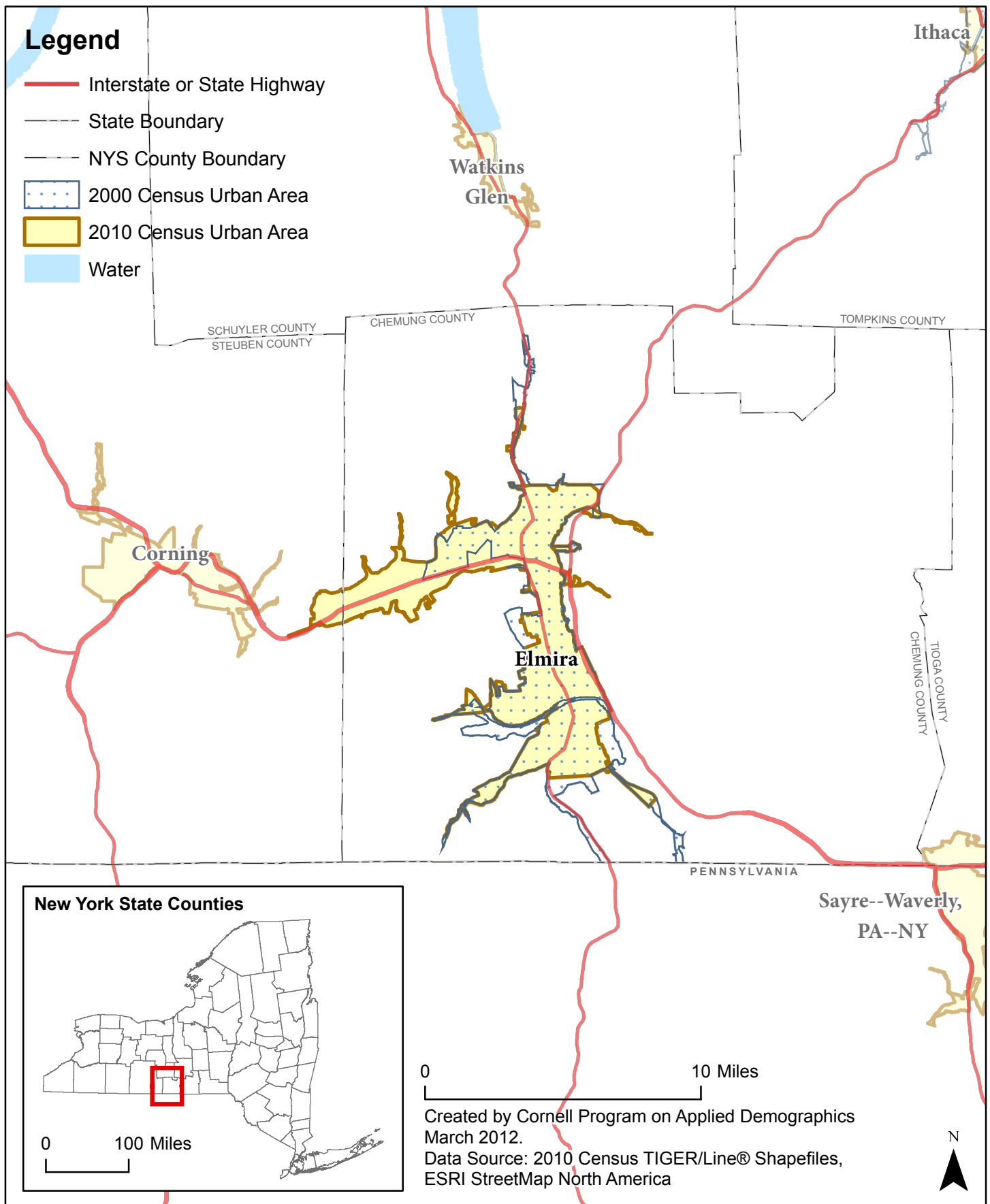

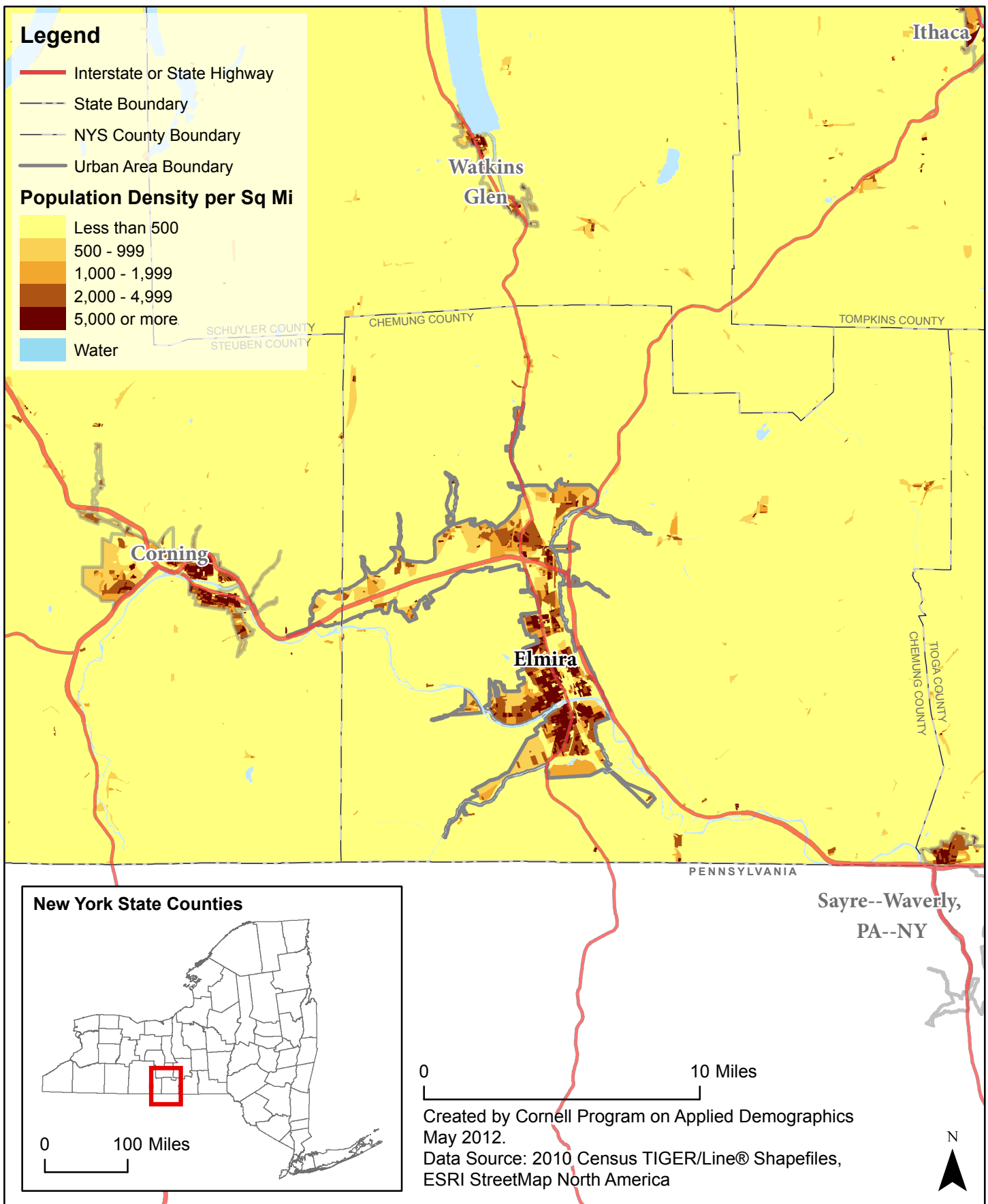

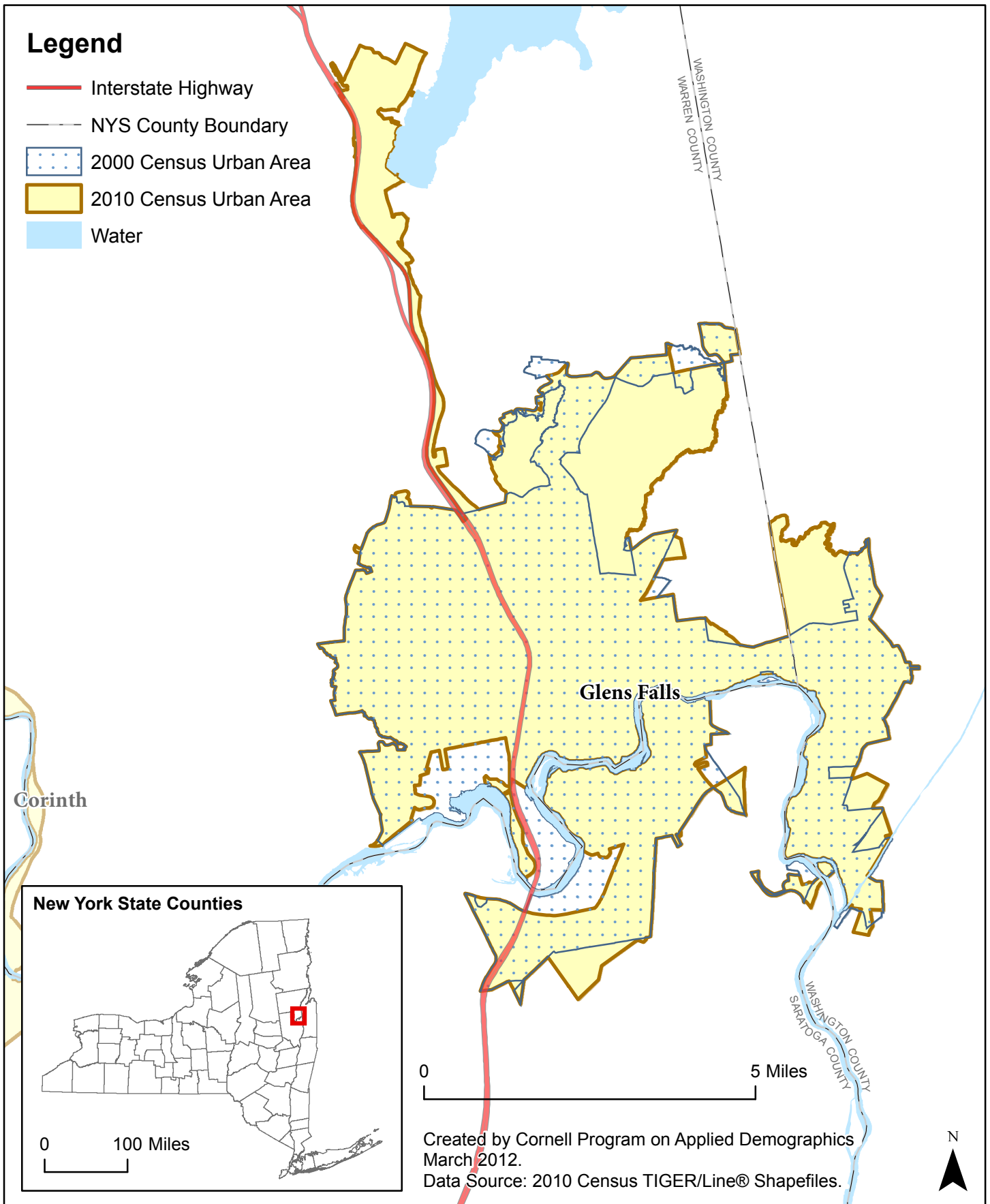

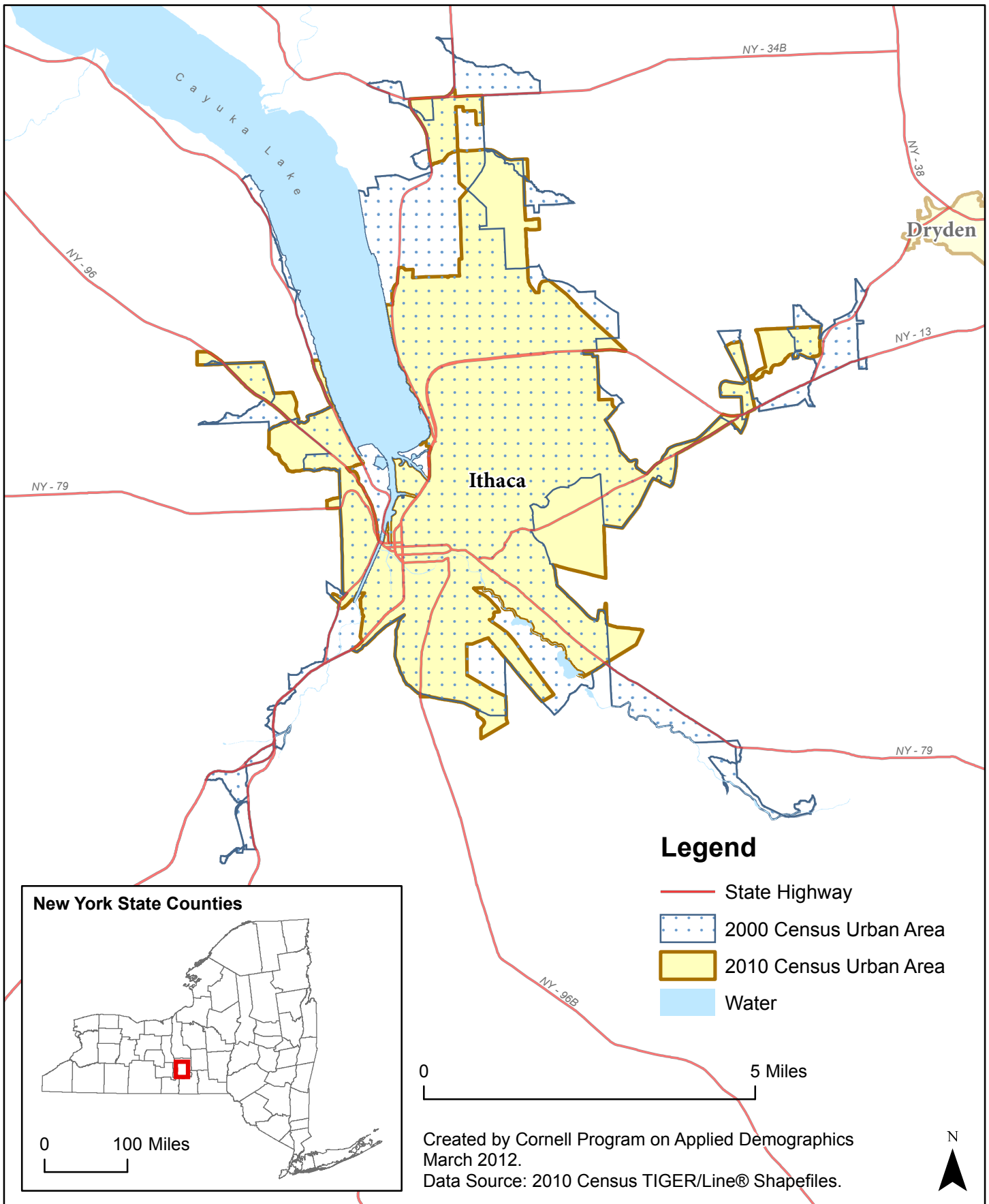

2010 Population Density Per Census Block



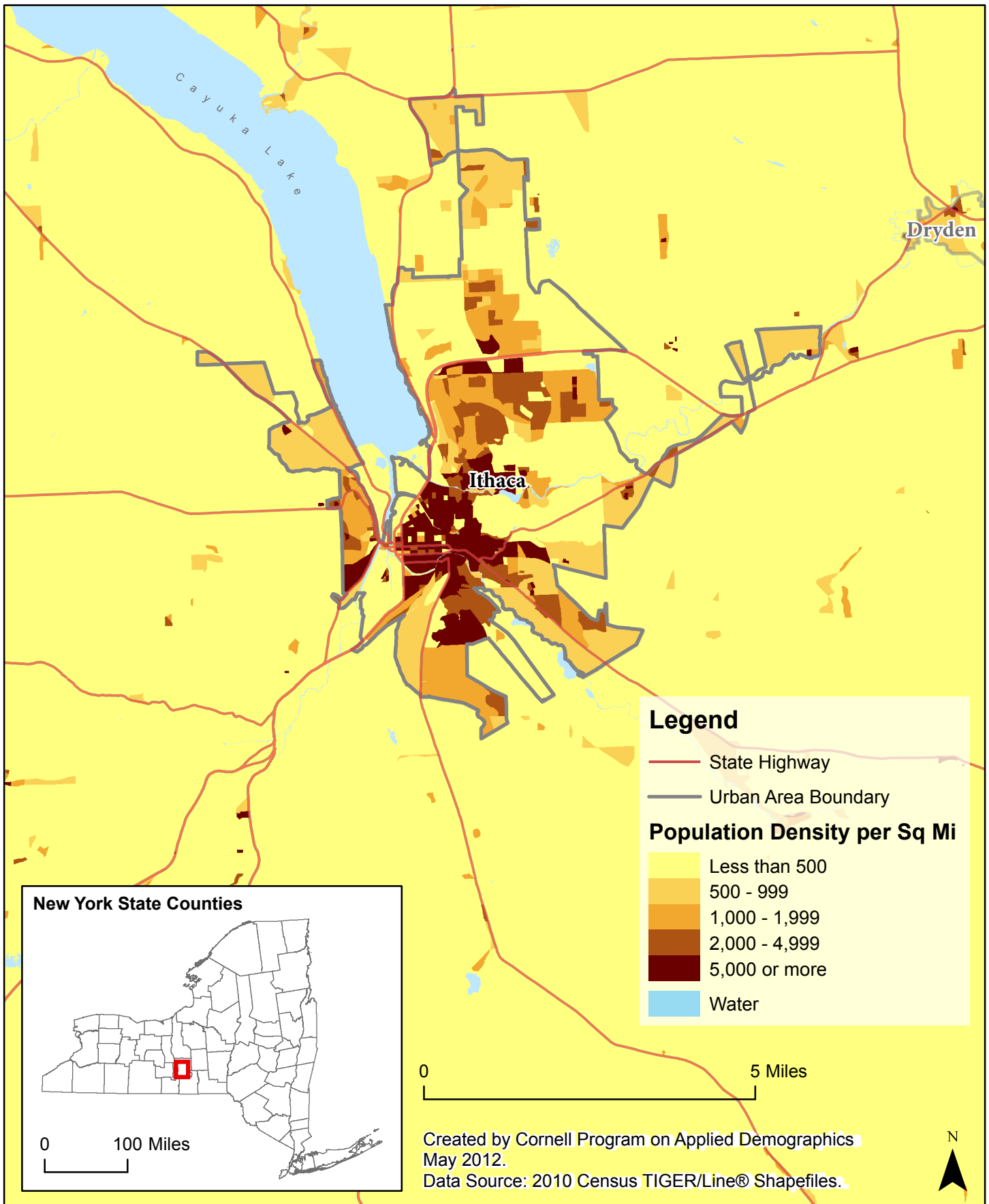

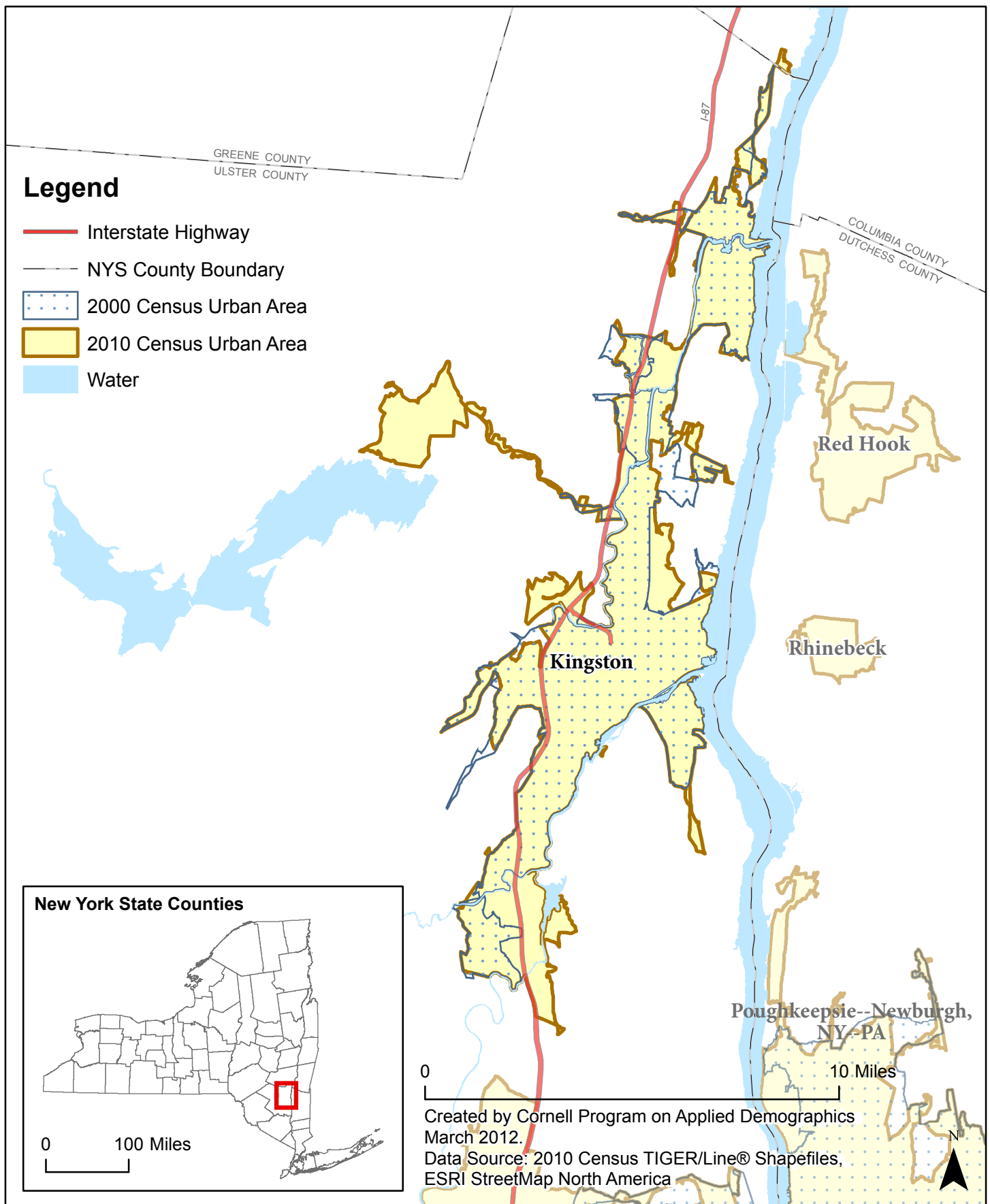

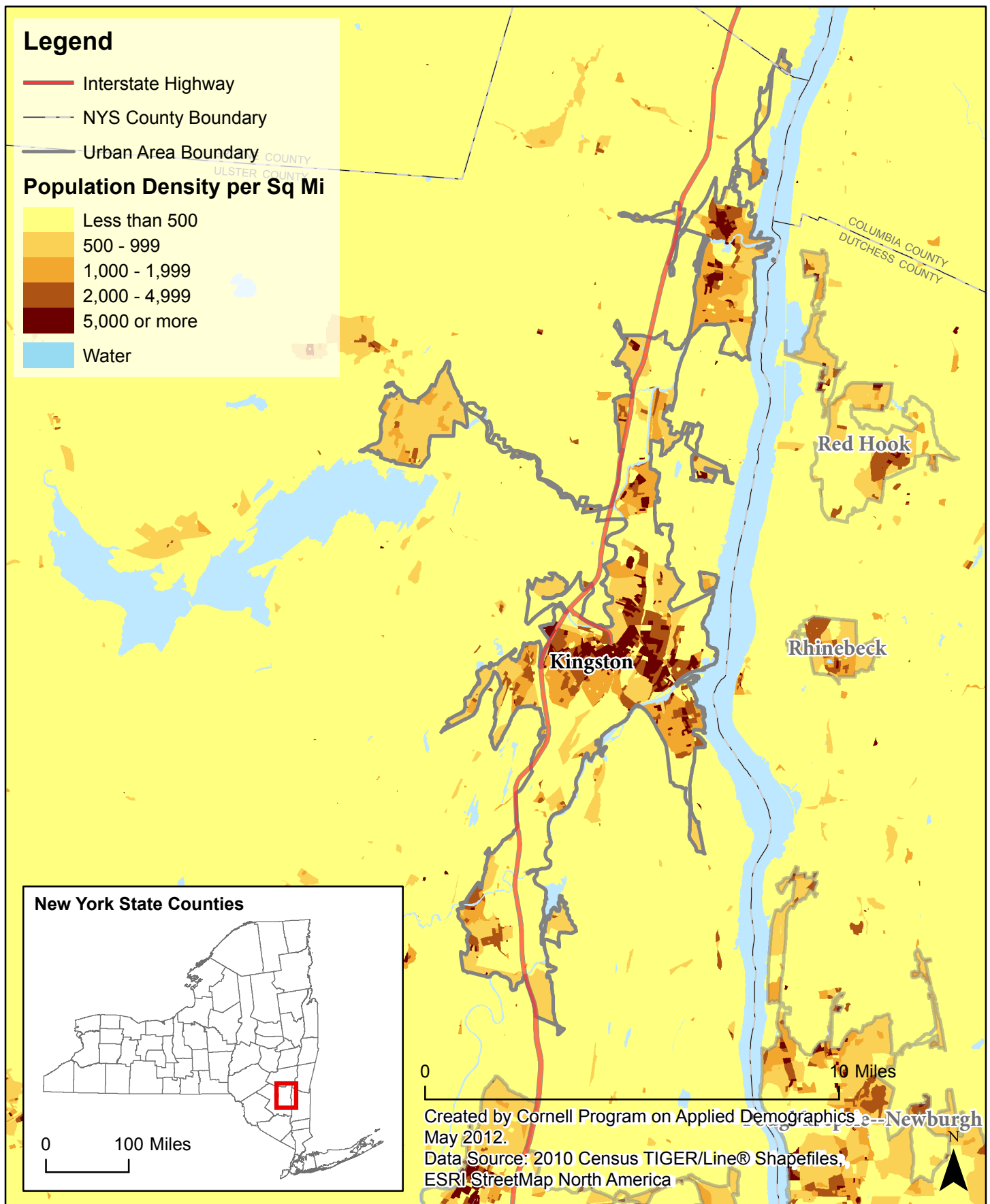

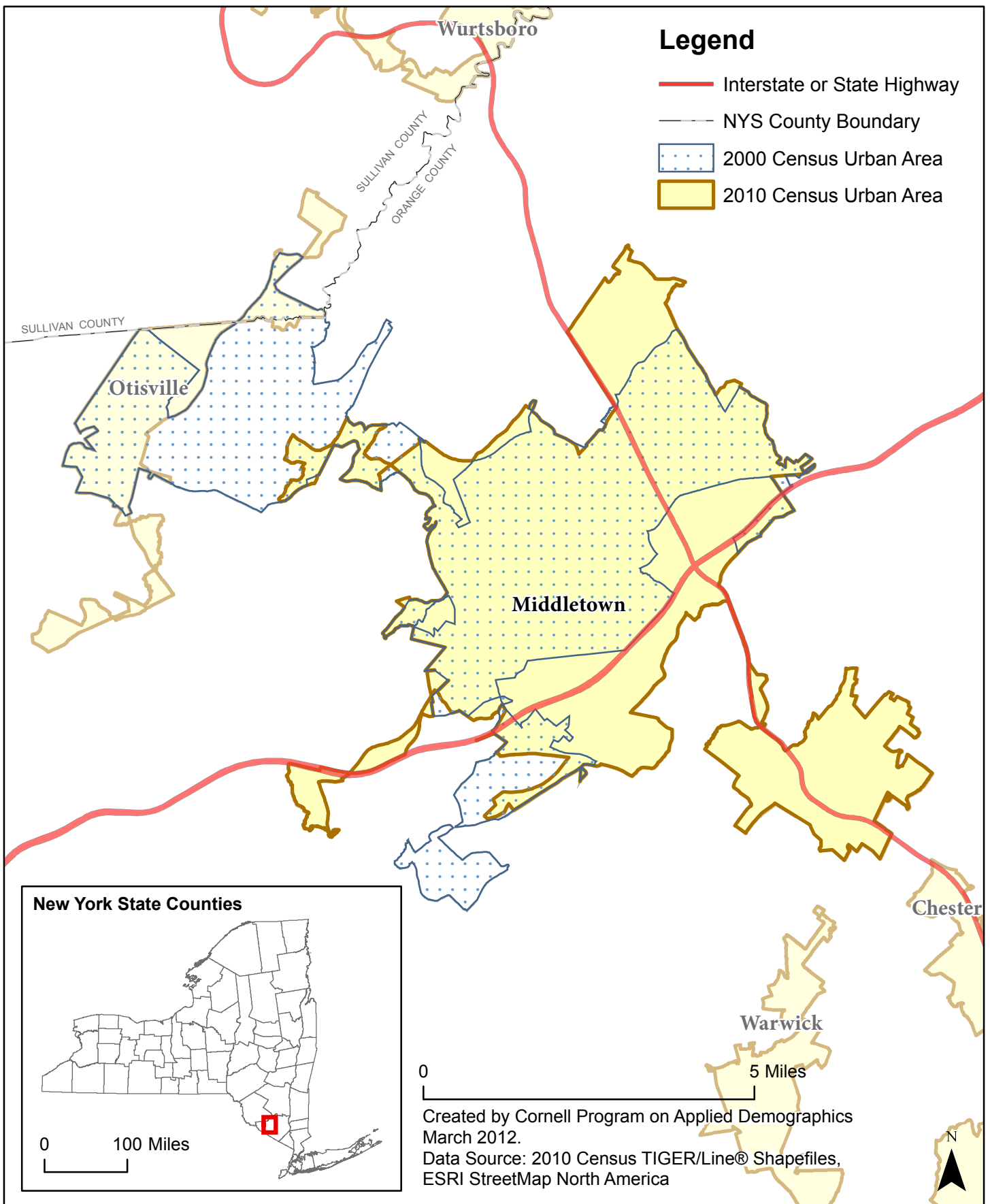

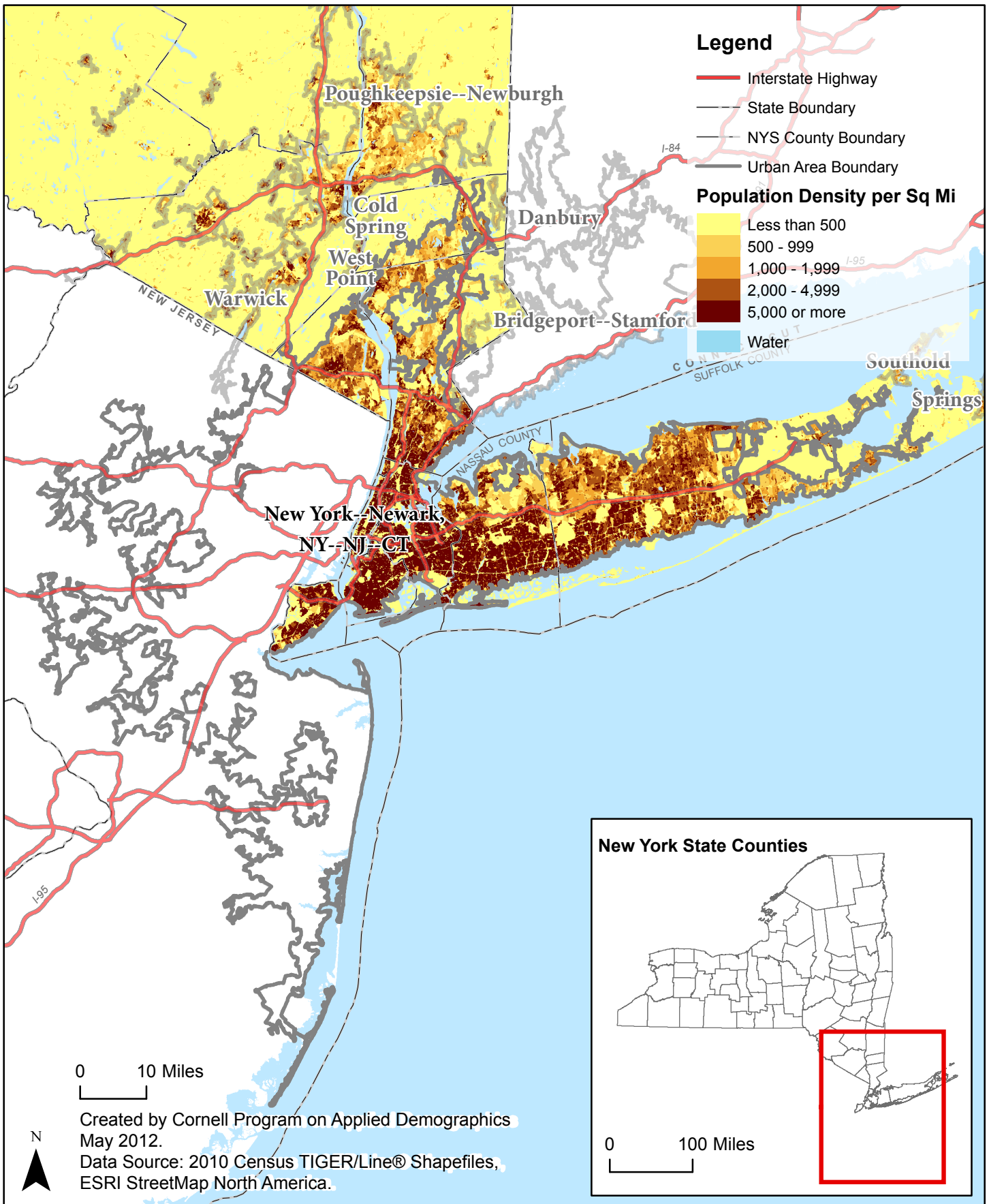

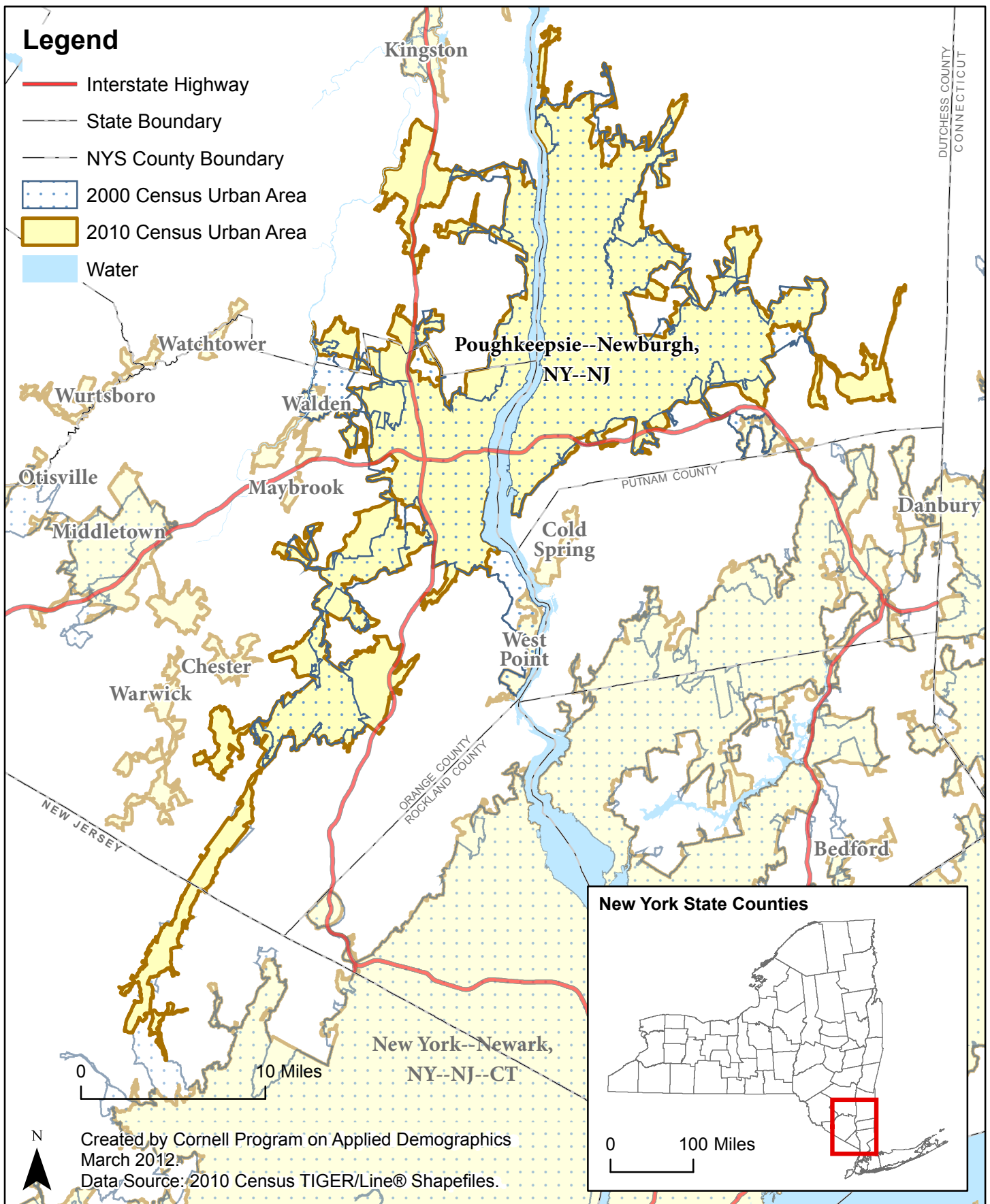

2010 Population Density Per Census Block



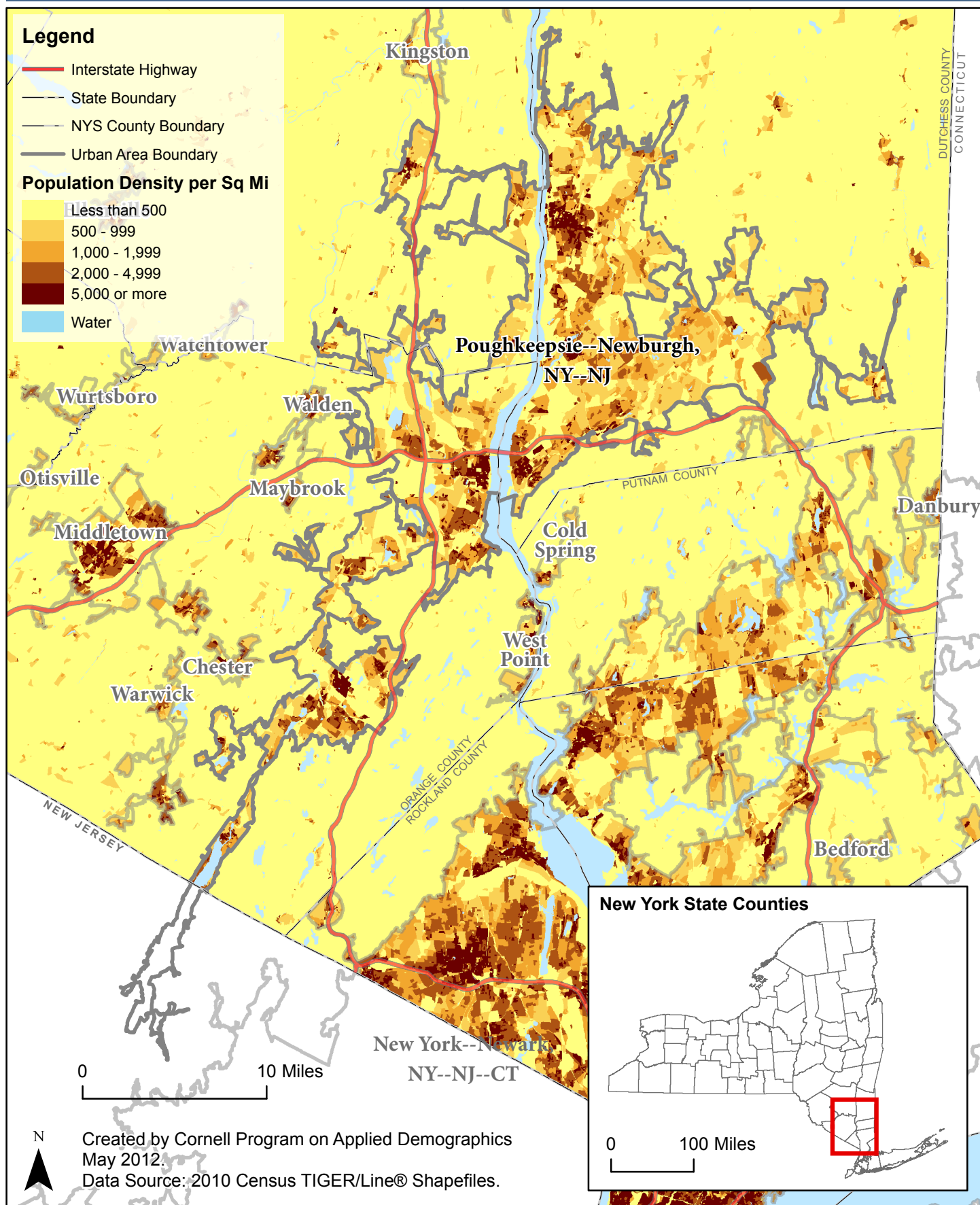
2010 Census Urban Area: Poughkeepsie--Newburgh, NY--NJ

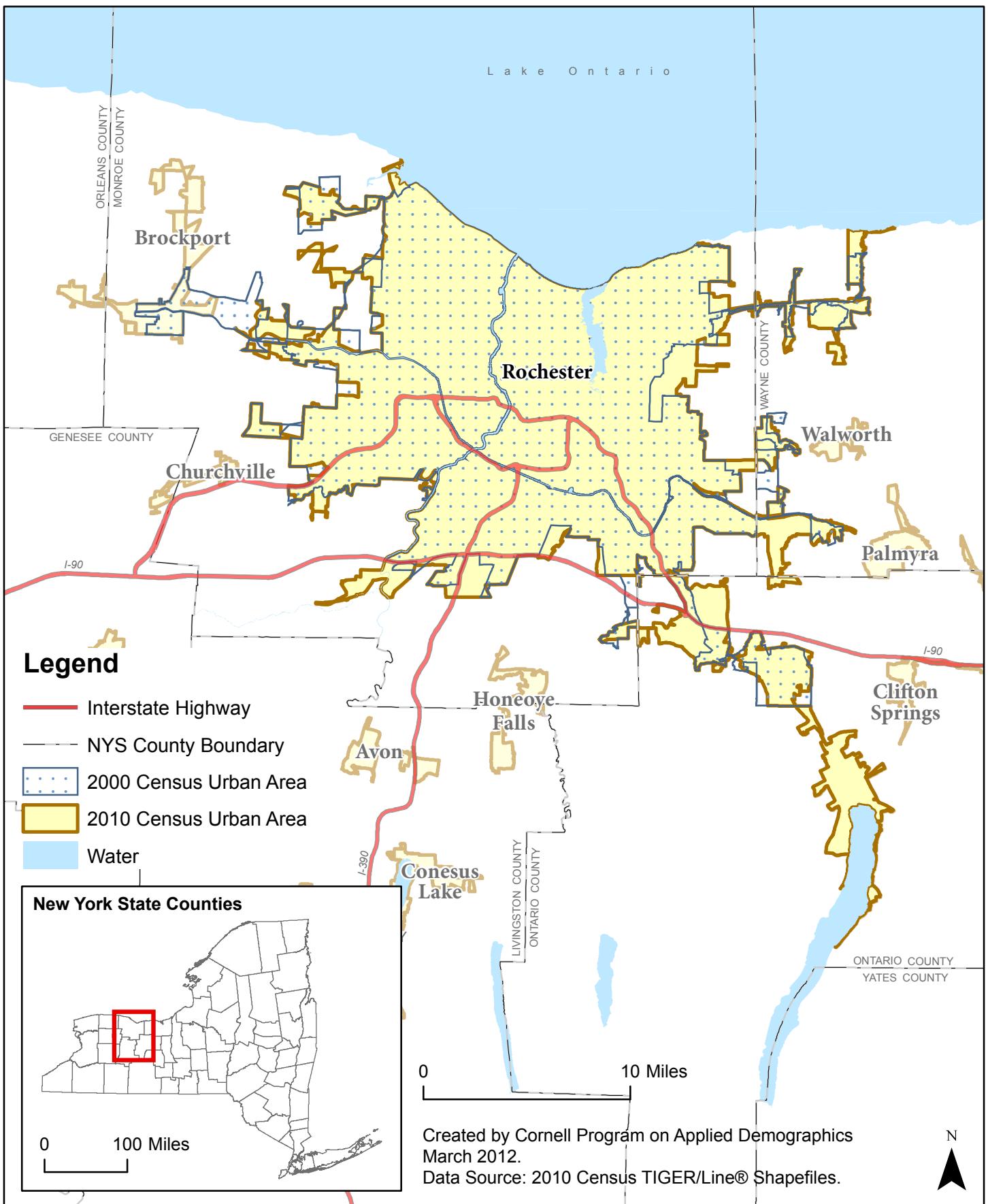

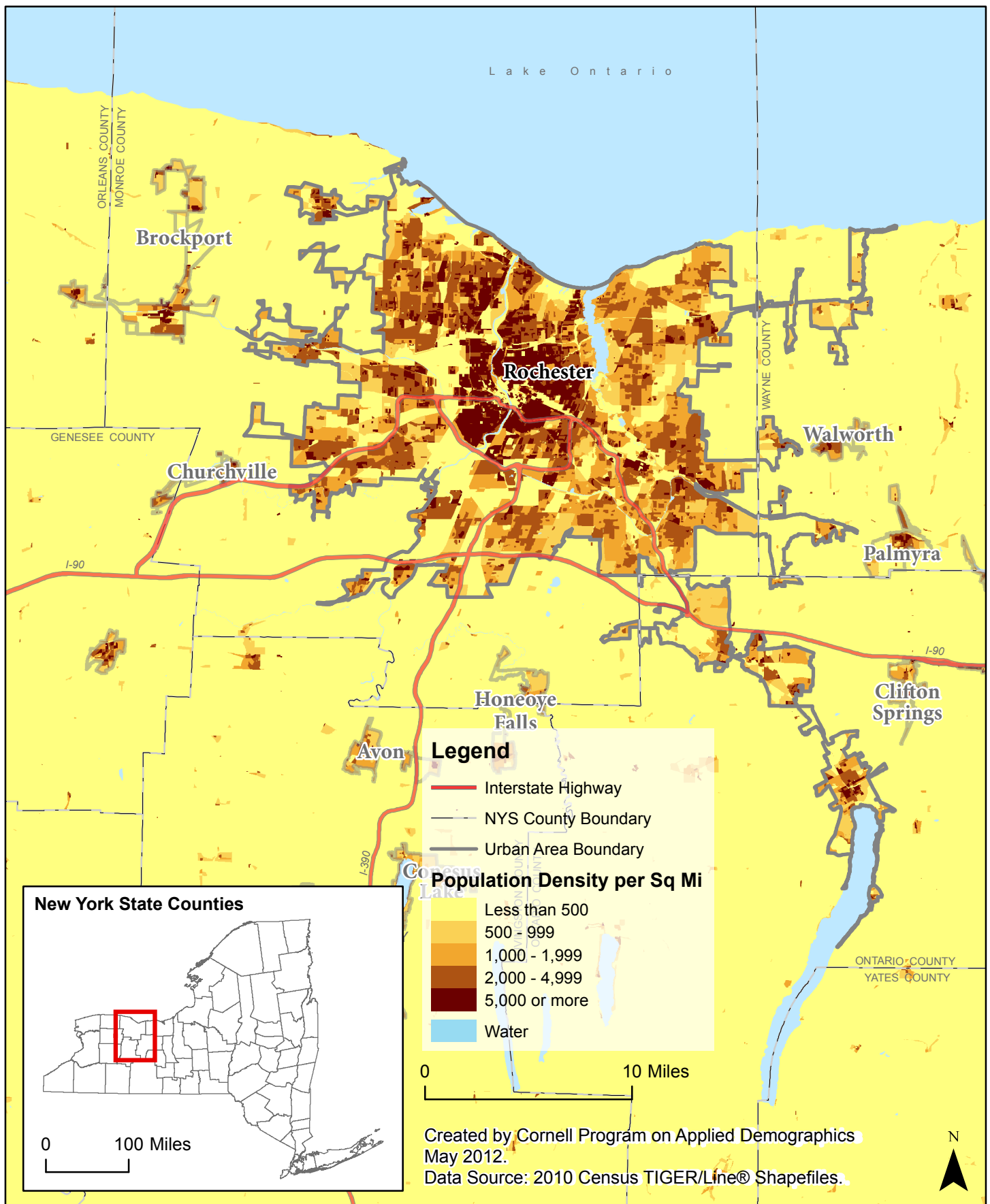

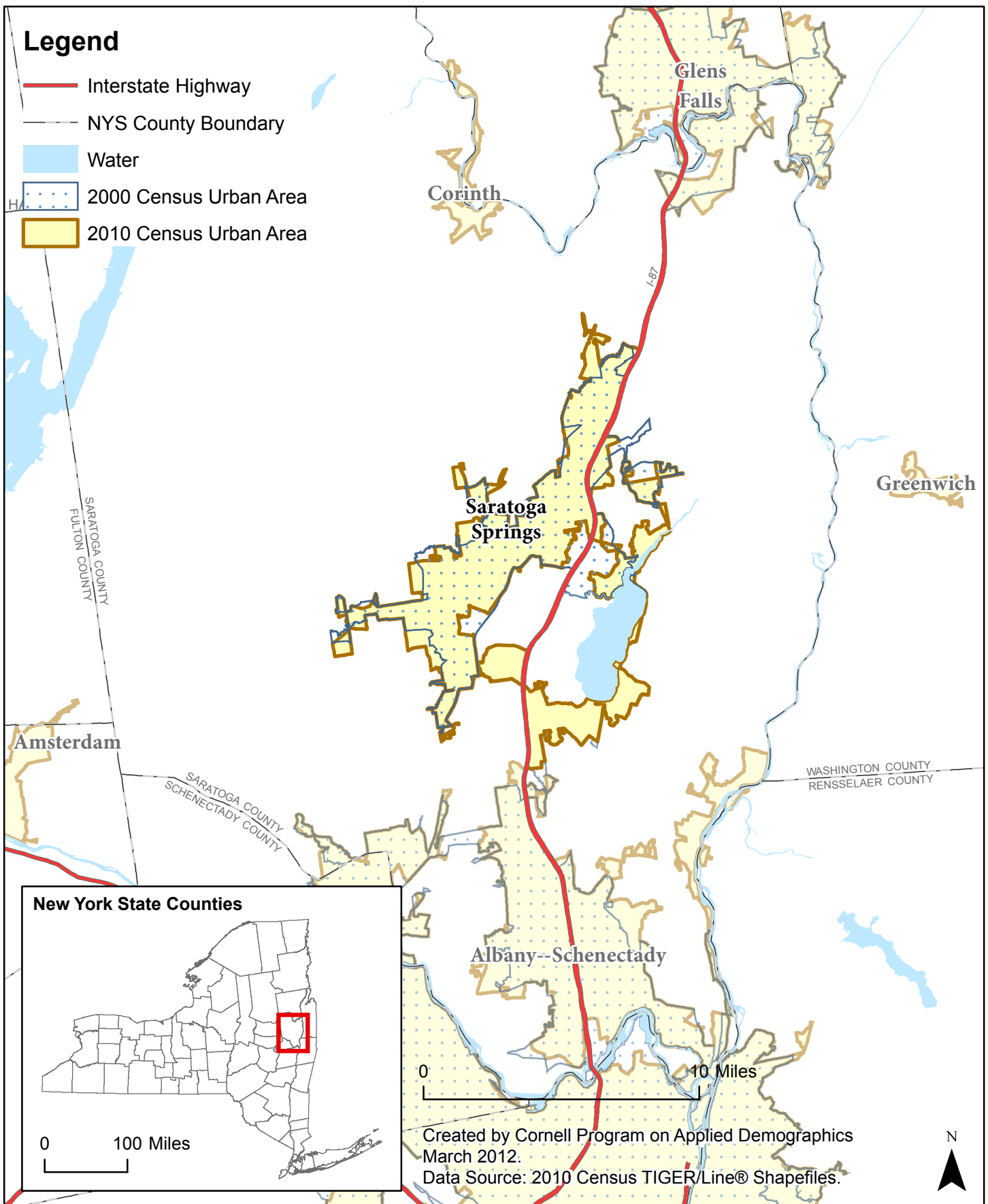

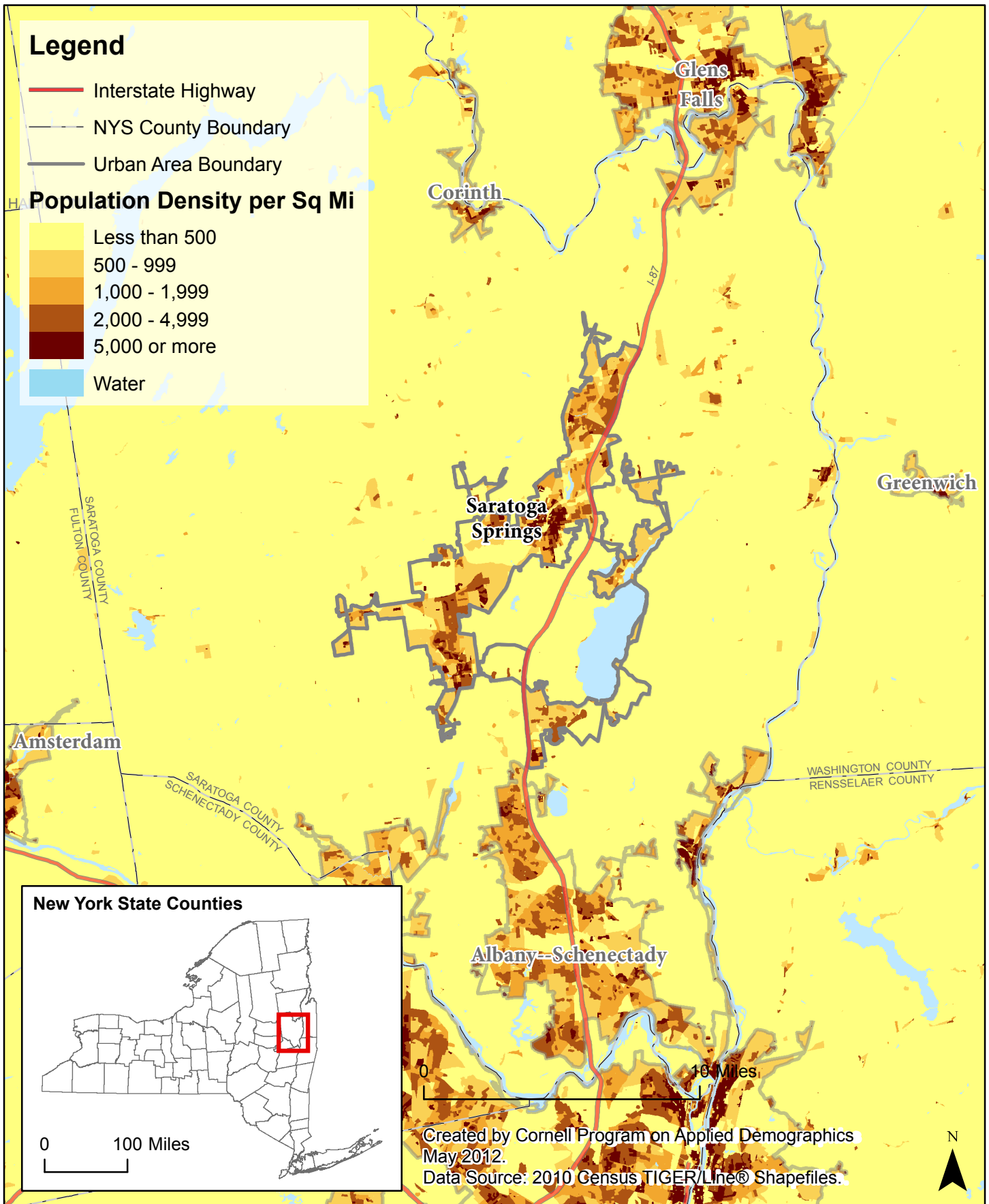

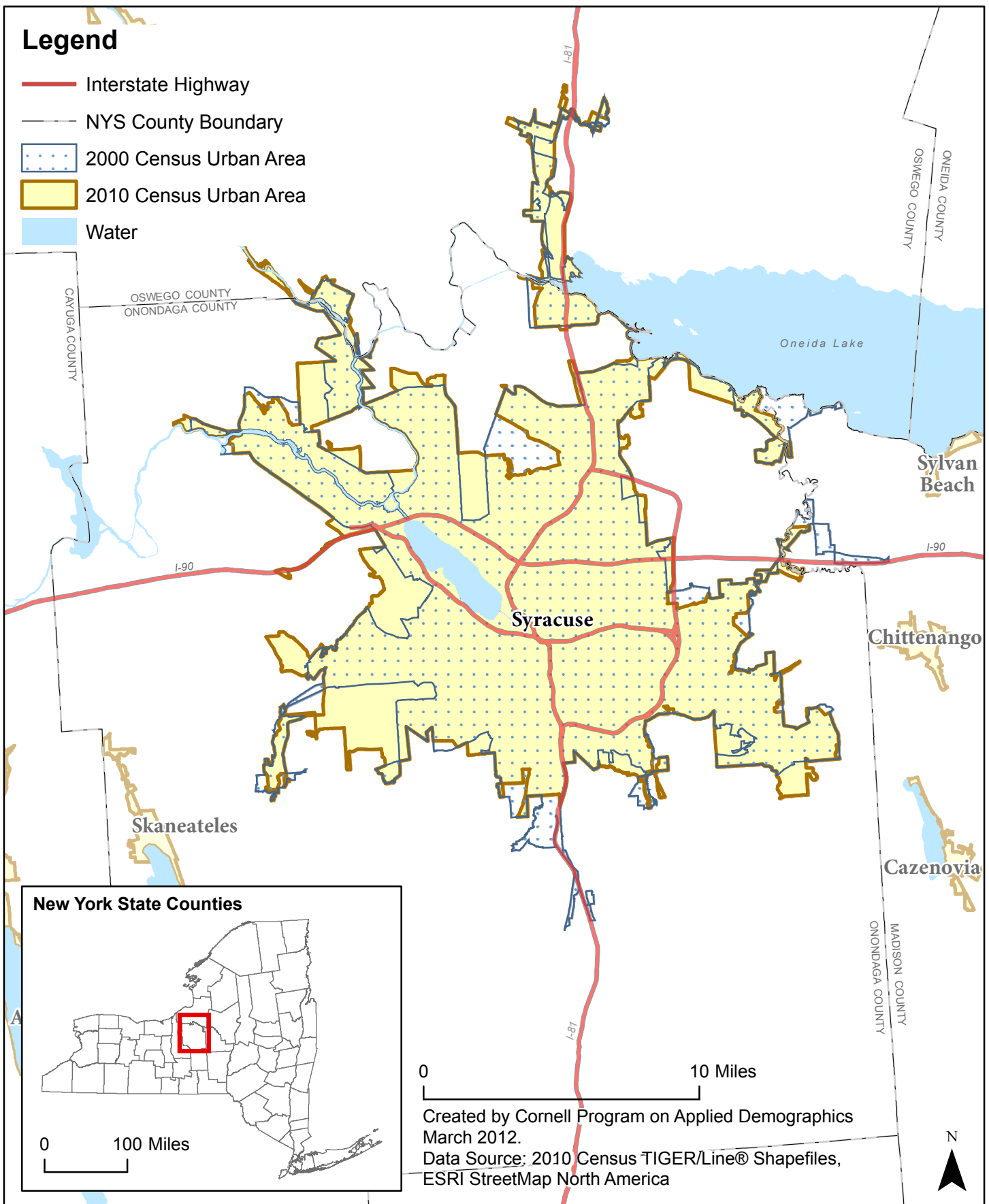

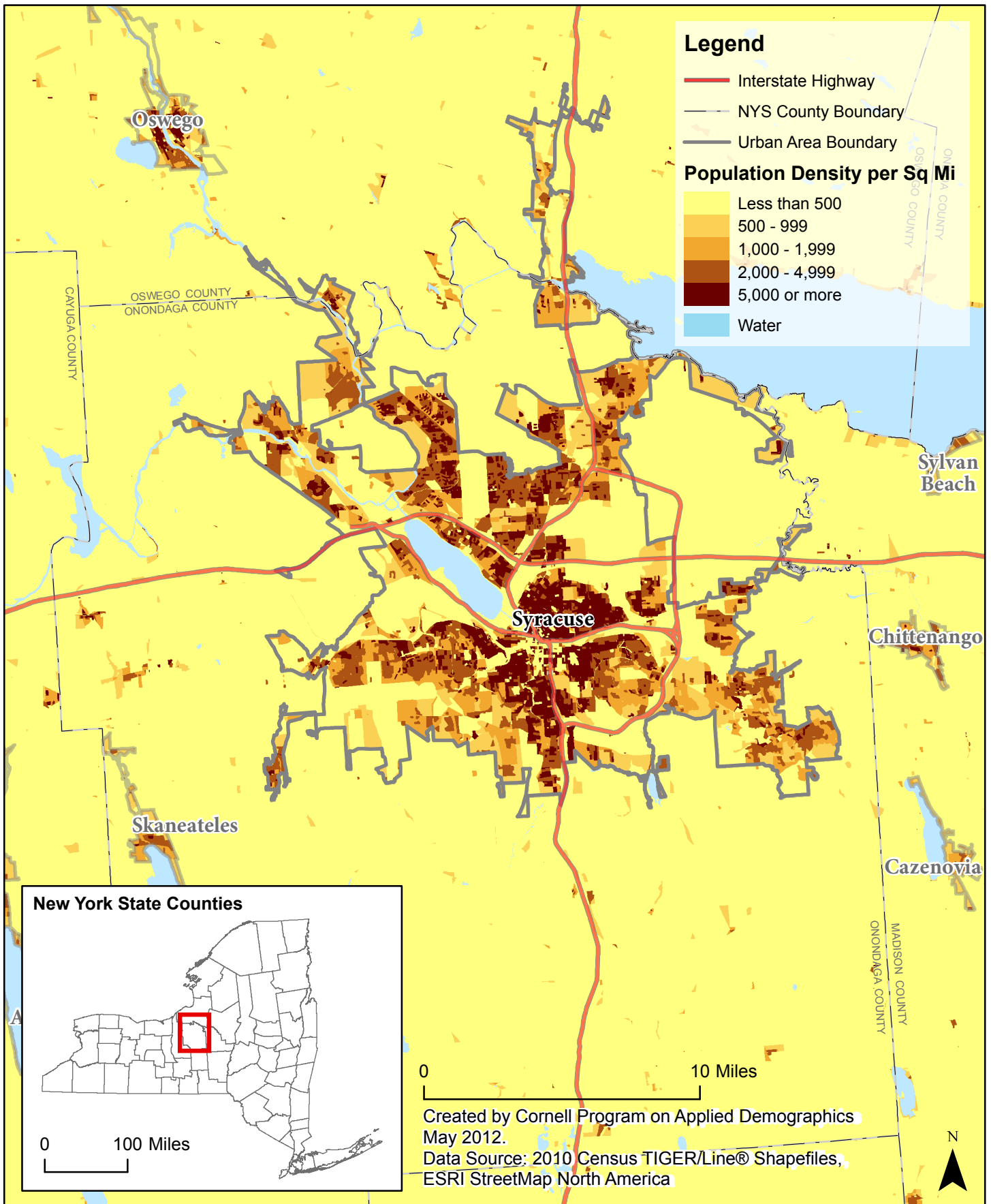

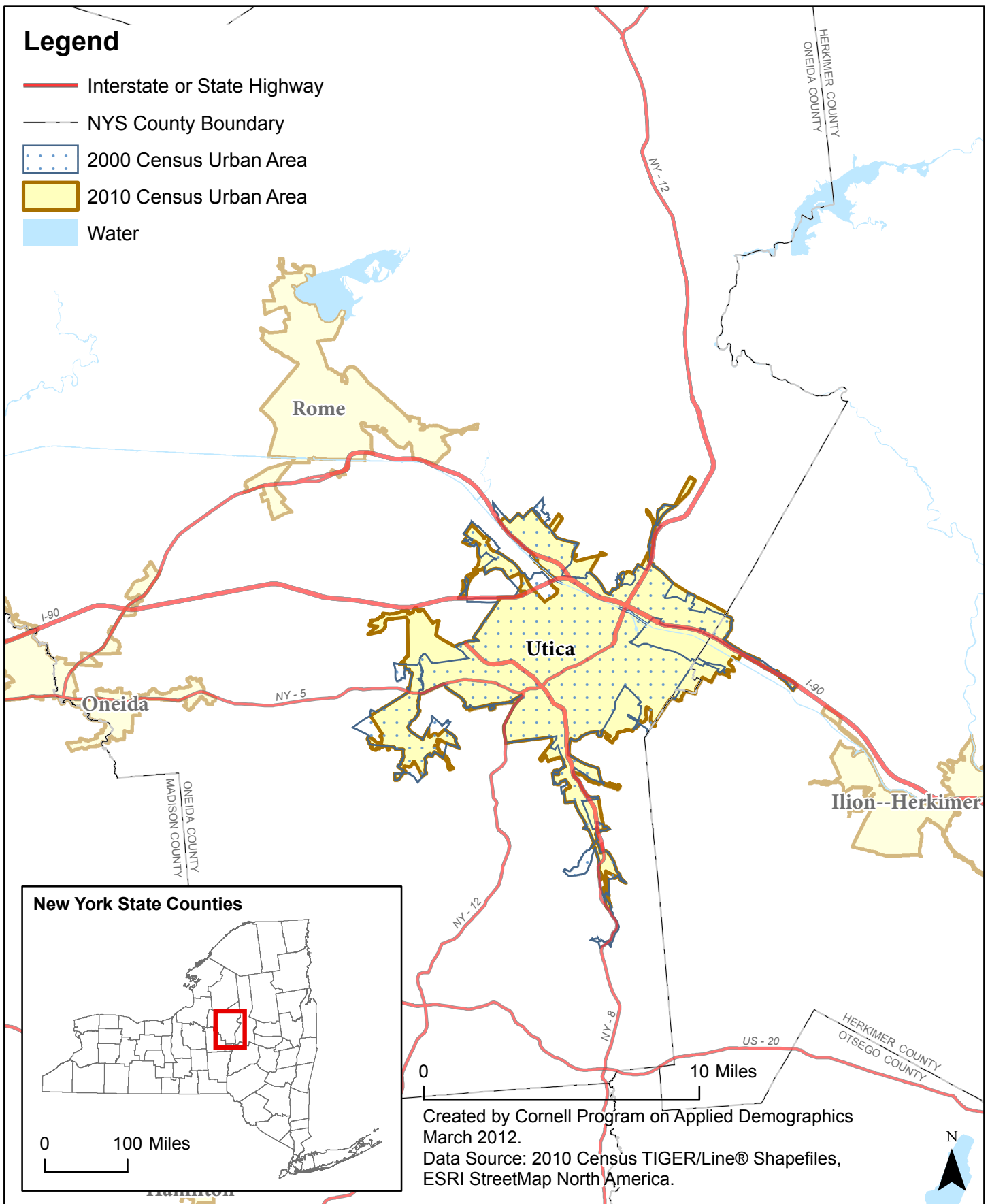

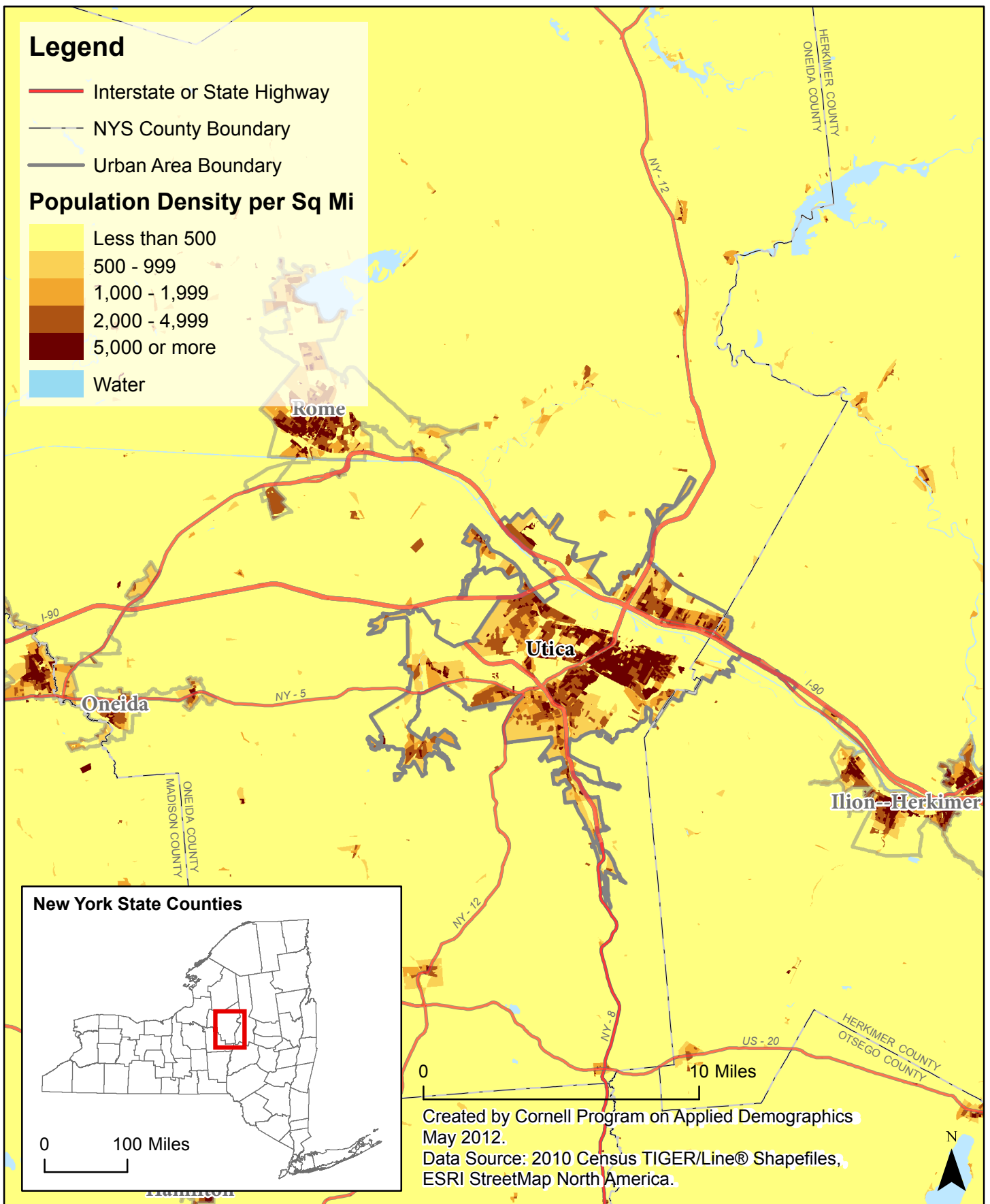

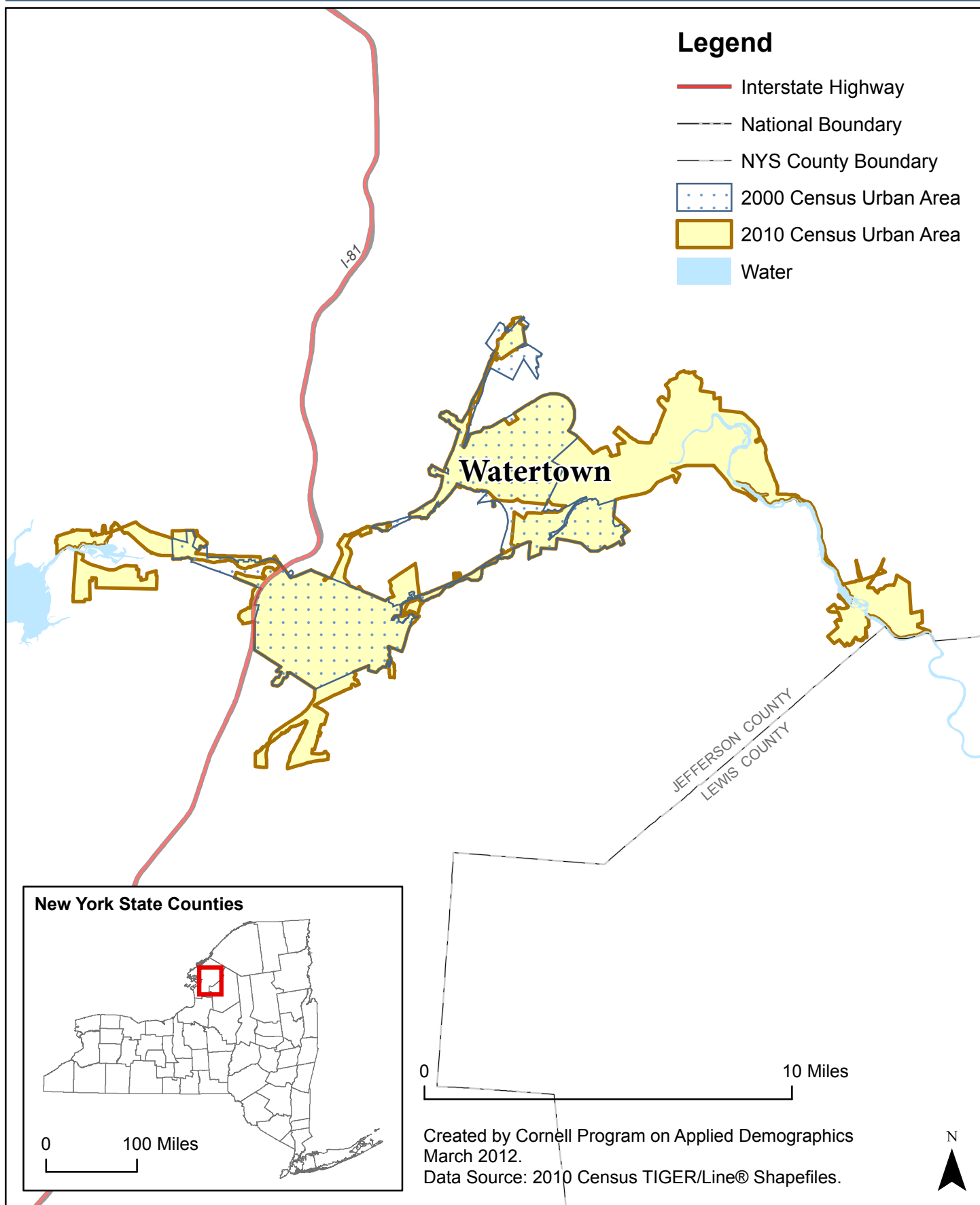

2010 Population Density Per Census Block



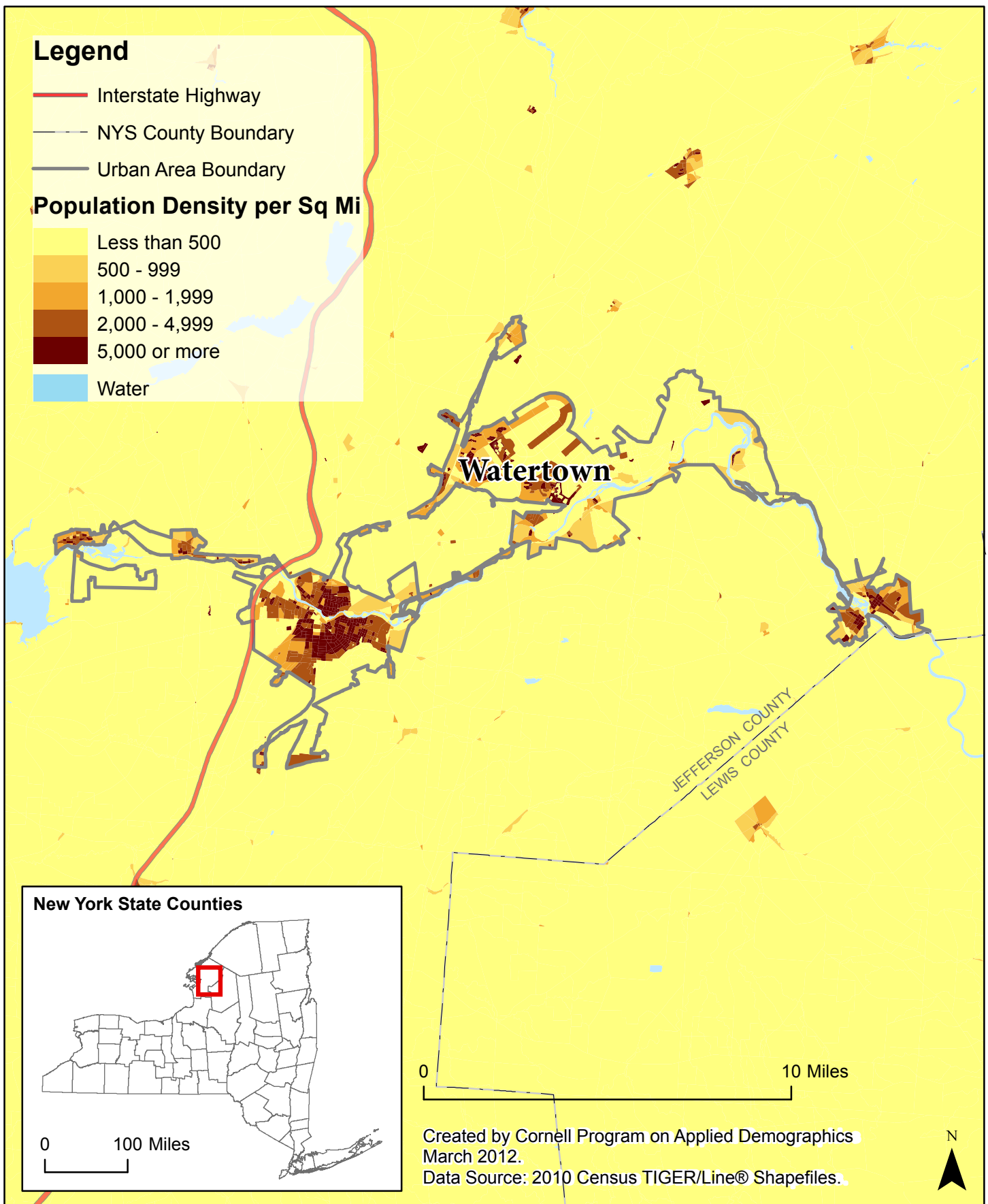
